

## Hallow, Anniversary, & Sharing Jesus

n Monday, our parish begins another Hallow Challenge. This time, we are doing the Surrender Novena which will be conjoined with a giving campaign. To access the **Surrender Novena**, you'll have to download the Hallow App, and join our parish community. Hit the "Community" button at the bottom of the page to access Hallow communities. Once you've joined the community, there will be an option to participate in the Surrender Novena.

As mentioned last week, this challenge will accompany a **giving campaign**. Part of our partnership with Hallow includes a giving campaign in which Hallow will match our collections up to \$5,000. We will divide the donations between our four capital improvement projects. Please take advantage of this offer! There are details in the bulletin about how to participate and donate.

Next Sunday is the 175<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Dedication of St. John Church. There will be an extra Mass to commemorate this occasion, celebrated by Archbishop Robert Casey, our new Archbishop. Mass will be at 1pm on Sunday, November 23. The Mass counts for your Sunday obligation.

In a particular way, I would like to invite everyone to attend. You may be thinking, "That would be cool to attend, but it'll be too crowded." Or "I don't normally go to Fryburg, so I don't want to intrude." That is nonsense. Seriously. When we had the Mass with the meal in September, there were 60 people in attendance. If there are only 60 people in attendance with the Archbishop, I don't think it would make a good impression. Moreover, the Browns play at 4pm.

Although the Bengals play at 1pm, their defense hasn't played all season, so you won't be missing anything!

Finally, I have heard some comments from people about **sharing adoration hours**. We are trying to have two people scheduled at each adoration hour. Some people are a little disappointed about this and I've heard a couple of reasons. First, people are worried that a second person may want to talk to them in the chapel. This is a real fear; our chapels can be way too talkative. If people are coming to adoration, it is more important to talk to Jesus Christ than the person next to them. Also people are worried about what others will think of them. What happens if they are crying before the Blessed Sacrament or snoring? These are all legitimate fears. We enjoy having our time with Jesus. On the rare time that I am the only person at our morning Holy Hour at St. John, it is a little treat.

However, the Church asks us to have two people to always guard the Blessed Sacrament. There are numerous reasons for this, which I've mentioned before. But one recent analogy came to mind. Before the Blessed Sacrament, many of us have been like only children. We have had Jesus to ourselves. It's not a bad thing, but we haven't had to sit near anybody or interact with anyone else. Now it is like there is a new child in the home. Suddenly, we aren't the only one in the house. We must share Jesus with someone else. This will cause us to change, which isn't a bad thing.

Then we will move to St. Joseph Hall where St. Nicholas will be sharing his story with us as we enjoy cookies and hot chocolate!



#### Scammers

Please be aware that scammers have been known to impersonate our priests with a text/email that says something like: "Hi, please return my text when you get it. I have a favor to ask." "Are you available?" Their text/email will probably even be signed with the name of one of our priests. If you engage with the scammer, they will likely ask for iTunes gift cards. Our priests will never send messages like this. If you're ever questioning a message, please call the parish office before responding. Ignore the message (or report it as a "phishing message") and say a prayer for the scammer.

#### **Pastoral Council**
