

Here Comes the King

Today, we celebrate **The Solemnity of Jesus Christ,** the King of the Universe, which is commonly called, "Christ the King." This feast day was instituted 100 years ago in 1925. It was instituted in response to secularism and atheism. As the USCCB states, "This solemnity reminds us that, while governments come and go, Christ reigns as King forever."

Every Sunday, we get to meet Jesus the King, at Mass. We meet Him in the Word of God, in our brothers and sisters, and, most especially, in the Eucharist. Think of how special it would be to meet the pope or the president, yet each Sunday, we are spoiled to meet Jesus Christ the King. We are blessed beyond measure that our King has the ability and the desire to be so close to us. We can encounter Him in countless ways.

Meeting the king elicits a response. If we met the pope or the president, it would be a once-in-a-lifetime event and we would make the most of the opportunity. What if we thought about Sunday Mass in the same way? This leads to a story...

When Fr. Leo Patalinghug visited our parish last Lent, we had some great conversations. At one point, I asked him, "What advice would you give me or our parish in general?" He gave very specific feedback. He said that it would elevate our experience at Sunday Mass if our Liturgical Ministers dressed better. I was taken aback by his directness; his response was not what I expected.

After thinking about his suggestion, praying about what could be done, and consulting with the staff and pastoral council, we have created a **Liturgical Attire Policy** for ministers (lectors, servers, ushers, etc). We are purposely sending this out in coordination with the Solemnity of Christ the King. Jesus is the King and

worshipping Him means that we should dress for the occasion. If you meet the President of the United States, there are certain guidelines; why not have guidelines for those ministering to the King of the Universe?

This policy will go into effect on January 1, 2026, which will give people time to put new clothes on their Christmas list, if needed. I realize that this policy may not affect you at all. On the other hand, you may be taken aback or offended by the policy. Also, you may struggle with it because "formal attire" and the fashion industry have changed over the years and it can be difficult to find clothes. The goal is to provide clear directions and uniformity while elevating the experience at Sunday Mass for everyone.

We have emailed the policy to our Liturgical Ministers and there are copies near the doors. The goal of the policy is to **elevate the Liturgy**. It gives us a greater sense of purpose. One of my high school teachers gave us bonus points on tests if we wore a shirt and tie. He said, "if you look good, you feel good. And if you feel good, you do good." He believed that our attire heightened our sense of purpose (even if it was taking a test). Something similar happens to us at Mass. I will also be participating in this policy. At Saturday evening and Sunday Mass, I'll be trading in my sandals for dress shoes.

Finally, next Sunday, **Advent begins!** How is that possible? Our parish will be participating in the **Hallow Advent Challenge**. Please sign up for this powerful Advent journey!
