Baptism of the Lord - January 11th, 2026

Setting the Stage

This Sunday we celebrate the **Feast of the Baptism of the Lord**. Jesus' Baptism inaugurates His public ministry. The story is at the beginning of the Gospel and after a quick skirmish with the devil in the desert, Jesus teaches, heals, and forms His new disciples. The Baptism sets the stage for all of His public ministry.

Our own Baptism does something similar for us. It inaugurates us into the life of Christ and sets the stage for our lives as Christians. Today would be a great day to renew our baptismal promises. Over dinner tonight, parents could invite their children to renew their baptismal promises or spouses could do this for each other. You could use the following questions:

Do you reject Satan, and all his works, and all his empty promises? *I do.*

Do you believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth? *I do.*

Do you believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was born of the Virgin Mary, was crucified, died, and was buried, rose from the dead, and is now seated at the right hand of the Father? *I do.*

Do you believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting? *I do.*

Next Sunday we'll begin the annual **Catholic Ministries Appeal** which supports vital ministries

throughout the Archdiocese of Cincinnati including: the seminary, hospital ministry, college campus ministry, prison ministry, Catholic Charities, and many more. Last year we exceeded our goal and I hope and pray that we can exceed it again.

In next Sunday's Gospel, John the Baptist identifies Jesus by calling Him the "Lamb of God." With this in mind, we'll begin using the **Agnus Dei** for the Lamb of God next Sunday. It will be fairly simple. The musical tune follows one of the English tunes that we already know and the words repeat: Agnus Dei qui tollis peccata mundi, miserere nobis. Agnus Dei qui tollis peccata mundi, miserere nobis. Agnus Dei qui tollis peccata mundi, dona nobis pacem.

Finally, I have the unfortunate responsibility of letting you know that **Bill Steinke** will be retiring at the end of the month. Bill has been the maintenance worker at St. Joseph Church and school for over 25 years. Currently, he is our longest-tenured employee. He knows every nook and cranny of our building and he is a tireless worker. He is always the first one in to unlock the church. We'll miss his work-ethic, knowledge, and constancy. 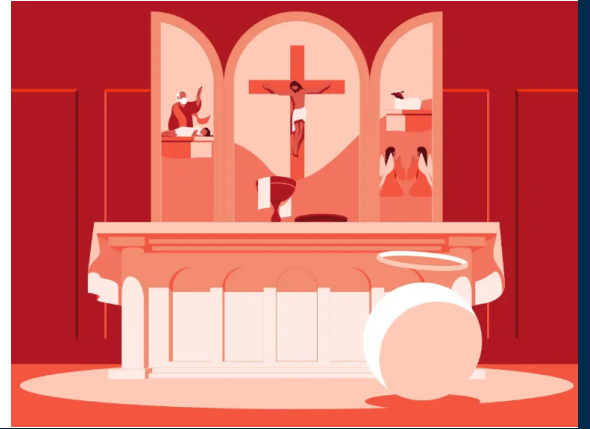
