Capital Improvement Recap

appy Gaudete Sunday! Last week, we had a town hall meeting about the capital improvement projects that will begin in 2025. The meeting was recorded and posted on YouTube. I thought it would be important to give a brief overview here. There are many more details in the video.

All of the projects we are undertaking are maintenance of the existing structures. There aren't any extravagant new buildings. We are simply maintaining what God has given us.

At St. Lawrence Church and St. John Church, the stained-glass windows need refurbished. We have contracted Window Creations to complete these two projects. Last summer, St. Lawrence completed the exterior storm windows. The exterior windows at St. John need replaced as well. The St. John windows will cost \$180,000 and the St. Lawrence windows will cost \$169,000.

At St. Joseph Church, we are still working on the renovation of the Faith Center, which was built in 1900 and hasn't had a serious renovation since 1949. At this point, all the windows have been replaced, the brick has been tuck-pointed, and the roof was replaced, along with a couple other smaller projects. So far, we have spent around \$968,000 on the Faith Center.

Now we need to renovate the interior of the building. This will include adding walls, bathrooms, an elevator, new HVAC, electrical, and plumbing systems. Along with this, we will replace the parking lot and add a couple light poles.

The plan is to move the parish offices into this newly-renovated space. Our current offices do not have an elevator which makes it difficult for some parishioners to enter. Also, the offices are difficult to find, if you don't know where to look. There is plenty of room in the Faith Center for the parish offices. There will still be room for CCD, God's Storehouse, St. Vincent de Paul, and Catechesis of the Good Shepherd in the Faith Center.

For this project, we have contracted HA Dorsten from Minster. Their bid is roughly \$2.8 million. Also, we will

need to set aside some money for contingencies. With contingencies, new furniture and other utilities, we need to set aside \$3.7 million for this project.

Finally, we are working on a new pipe organ at Immaculate Conception. We aren't quite ready to seek bids for this project, but a committee has been formed and we are working with a consultant to complete the project. There are various kinds of organs and different builders to choose from. This is still a work in progress, but we would like to budget \$500,000 for this project, knowing that it may cost more.

All of these expenses are around \$4.5 million, which is a hefty sum. Providentially, the Lord has blessed our parish. We have \$2.98 million in unrestricted savings. Parishioners have already given over \$20,000 for the IC organ. Also \$25,000 has been given by the Kleinhenz-Moeller Foundation for the parking lot at St. Joseph Church. We also have \$1 million dollars in a restricted gift and a \$1.5 million dollar pledge to renovate the Faith Center.

We have about \$5.5 million in available funds. Therefore, Pastoral Council, the Finance Committee, and the Buildings and Grounds Committee unanimously recommended completing all four of these projects.

Although we have the available funds, we would like to invite all parishioners to prayerfully consider donating to these projects. People seem excited about all four projects, so we have set a fundraising goal for each project. For the windows at St. John and St. Lawrence, we would like to raise \$50,000 each. For the Faith Center renovation at St. Joseph, we would like to raise \$300,000. For the organ at Immaculate Conception, we would like to raise \$150,000. You can write a check to the "Holy Face of Jesus Parish" and include the particular project in the memo line.

Again, the video online has many more details about the upcoming projects. Thank you for your generosity. May the Lord continue the good work that he has begun.



Precepts of the Catholic Church

See Catechism of the Catholic Church, paragraphs 2041–2043

1. You shall attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation and rest from servile labor.

Requires the faithful to participate in the Eucharistic celebration when the Christian community gathers together on the day commemorating the Resurrection of the Lord

2. You shall confess your sins at least once a year.

Ensures preparation for the Eucharist by the reception of the sacrament of reconciliation, which continues Baptism's work of conversion and forgiveness

3. You shall humbly receive your Creator in Holy Communion at least once a year during the Easter season.

Guarantees as a minimum the reception of the Lord's Body and Blood in connection with the Paschal feasts, the origin and center of the Christian liturgy

4. You shall observe the prescribed days of fasting and abstinence established by the Church.

Ensures the times of ascesis and penance which prepare us for the liturgical feasts and help us acquire mastery over our instincts and freedom of heart

5. You shall provide for the needs of the Church.

The faithful are obliged to assist with the material needs of the Church, each according to his own ability


