

A handful of people have noticed that there are missing pictures in our churches. I thought that we could sneak this out with nobody noticing, but you pay attention to detail. Nothing gets by you.

Traditionally, Catholic Churches have a picture of the Pope and the local Bishop near the entrance. I'm not sure how this started or when it started, but it is definitely a thing. It shows our unity and deference to the universal Church in the person of the Pope. Locally, it highlights the importance of the local Church which is guided by our Bishop.

Our four churches have various pictures of the Pope and the Archbishop. Some only have a picture of Pope Francis, others have mismatched pictures of Pope Francis and Archbishop Schnurr. One of our churches didn't have a picture of the Pope or the Archbishop. With the appointment of a new Archbishop, it seemed like an opportune time to ensure that all four churches have a matching picture of Pope Francis and Archbishop Casey. In the coming weeks, each church will have pictures of these two men in matching frames.

Speaking of opportune time... now is an opportune time to prepare for **the parish mission**. After months of planning, promoting, and praying, our parish mission begins next week. Please continue to pray for an outpouring of God's grace upon our parish and upon Fr. Leo Patalinghug, who is leading the mission. Please pay attention to the details in the bulletin about parking, the schedule, and the various events. Use your eagle eyes to watch all these means of communication.

In a particular way, I'd like to thank so many people who have planned this mission. First and foremost, Angie Soules, our Director of Evangelization, has led these efforts. She has been supported by many members of our parish staff and a parish mission committee. They have gone over every detail with exactitude and prayerfulness. Also, I would like to thank the trustees of the Kleinhenz-Moeller Foundation. They made a generous donation to help offset some of the costs of the parish mission.

Finally, I'd like to point your attention to the cover of the bulletin which has a picture of the Angel Gabriel announcing God's plan of salvation to the blessed Virgin Mary. Tuesday, March 25 is the **Solemnity of the Annunciation** and nine months until Christmas. This is a great feast day that commemorates the beginning of our salvation. Mary's "Yes" opens the door for Jesus to enter our world and free us from sin.

Since this solemnity occurs during Lent, it is important to celebrate it. Maybe you could relax your Lenten penance for a day. Also you could read the Gospel (Luke 1:26-38) and meditate on it. The Hail Mary contains part of the Angel's greeting to the Blessed Virgin Mary, "Hail Mary, full of Grace, the Lord is with you," so you could pray the Rosary, or at least a decade of it.

May you have a blessed Solemnity of the Annunciation, and I look forward to seeing you at the parish mission.


St. John Church 175th Anniversary Event


