

The Week Ahead

A fter months of anticipation, our first Parish Mission in decades is finally here! I want to thank everyone who has helped plan, organize, and prepare for the mission. It has been a monumental undertaking, but an exciting one. We are blessed to have Fr. Leo Patalinghug join us, especially during this Jubilee Year!

A couple of notes for your participation in the Parish Mission. Arrive early; we are anticipating large crowds and with parking being limited, you may have to walk a couple of blocks. Regarding parking, pay attention to the bulletin insert. It highlights the various parking lots that are available in the neighborhood. The St. Joseph parking lot will be reserved for those who need special assistance or are handicapped. However, you can drop people off in the parking lot.

There will be a shuttle service at the Auglaize County Fairgrounds beginning at 5pm each evening. We are grateful for the local organizations that have allowed us to use their parking lots.

Later in the week is the Installation of Archbishop Robert Casey as the 10th Archbishop of Cincinnati. The installation Mass will be on Thursday, April 3rd at 2:00pm. The Mass is ticketed due to space restrictions. If you want to watch the installation Mass, it will be livestreamed on the Archdiocesan website catholicaoc.org. Please pray for Archbishop Casey and the entire Archdiocese of Cincinnati as we begin an exciting new chapter.

If you would like to get a glimpse of Archbishop Casey in action, you could attend the **Chrism Mass**. Each year during Holy Week, there is a large Mass to bless the Holy Oils that will be used throughout the year. Also, during this Mass, the priests of the Archdiocese recommit to the promises that we made at our ordination. This Mass will take place on Tuesday, April 15 at 3pm at the Cathedral Basilica of St. Peter in Chains. It is open to the public. If you are interested in attending and would like more information, feel free to reach out to me, Fr. Hoying, or David.

Finally, please pray for our Confirmandi. Our 10th graders will receive **the Sacrament of Confirmation** next Sunday, April 6th at 1:30pm at St. Joseph. Please pray that they receive an outpouring of grace from God and that they respond to the grace of the Sacrament. I get to participate in a lot of their formation for Confirmation and I'm really impressed with this group of 10th graders. They are a dynamite bunch.

Please pay attention to the Liturgical Schedule. A handful of families who have Confirmandi in the family are scheduled to usher, lector, cantor, or serve at Mass. If you're able to substitute for them, please do.

This is an exciting week in the parish. We are truly spoiled by God. His love and kindness are constantly poured out upon us.

Catholic Nurse Society in 2025




