

# Holy Week

vividly remember every Good Friday growing up. In our parish schedule, we had Stations of the Cross at noon and then Liturgy of the Lord's Passion started around 5pm. We would always go to the Stations of the Cross at noon as a family. It really helped us to experience the power of the Lord's Passion. After the Stations of the Cross, the house would remain quiet until at least 3:00pm. My parents wouldn't let us go to friends' houses, play video games or any other electronics. It was a time of quiet. We would pray, read, or go for a walk.

This week presents us with the opportunity to enter into the mysteries of our salvation. Beginning with Palm Sunday, we can experience the power of Jesus Christ. I want to give a few suggestions how to live Holy Week. I wouldn't recommend doing all of these, but maybe you could pick one or two.

• On Palm Sunday, we read the Passion Narrative of the Gospel of Luke (chapters 22 & 23). On the other days, you could read the other Passion Narratives: Matthew 26 & 27, Mark 14 & 15, and John 18 & 19

- Go to Confession!
- Attend the Chrism Mass in Cincinnati on Tuesday (details in the March 30th bulletin)
- Attend the Holy Thursday Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7:00pm at Immaculate Conception or St. Joseph
- Make the Seven Churches Pilgrimage
- At some point on Holy Thursday, as a family, wash each other's feet, imitating Jesus Christ

- Make the great fast: only consume liquids from Holy Thursday Mass until the Easter Vigil.
   A couple parishioners and I decided to do this.
   Who's with us?!!
- Participate in the Good Friday Liturgy of the Lord's Passion at 12:30pm at Immaculate Conception or 1:30pm at St. Joseph
- Begin the Novena to Divine Mercy on Good Friday
- Keep a quiet day on Good Friday, as mentioned above
- Attend the Stations of the Cross with the Veneration of the Cross at 7:00pm at St. Lawrence on Good Friday
- Attend the Easter Vigil and celebrate with the Risen Lord afterward!

I am sure that families and individuals can think of many creative ways to commemorate Our Lord's Passion, Death, and Resurrection. May you have a blessed Holy Week.



#### Fast & Abstinence Reminders

Good Friday, April 18, is a day of abstinence from meat and also a day of fast, that is, limited to a single full meal. The other Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence from meat. The law of abstinence binds all Catholics 14 years and older. The law of fasting binds all Catholics from their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday until their 59<sup>th</sup> birthday. (canons 97, 1252) "Let the paschal fast be kept sacred. Let it be celebrated everywhere on Good Friday and, where possible, prolonged throughout Holy Saturday, so that the joys of the Sunday of the Resurrection may be attained with uplifted and clear mind." (Constitution on the Liturgy, No. 110)



# **DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY**

Join us at Immaculate Conception Church Sunday, April 27th 3pm (Confessions begin at 2:30pm)

"On that day the very depths of My tender Mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy [the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Holy Eucharist]. The soul that will go to Confession [beforehand] and receive Holy Communion [on that day] shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment...The Feast of Mercy emerged from My very depths of tenderness." - St. Faustina's Diary 699

St. Pope John Paul II declared the Sunday after Easter Divine Mercy Sunday and in order that the faithful would observe this day with intense devotion, enriched it with an indulgence.
