

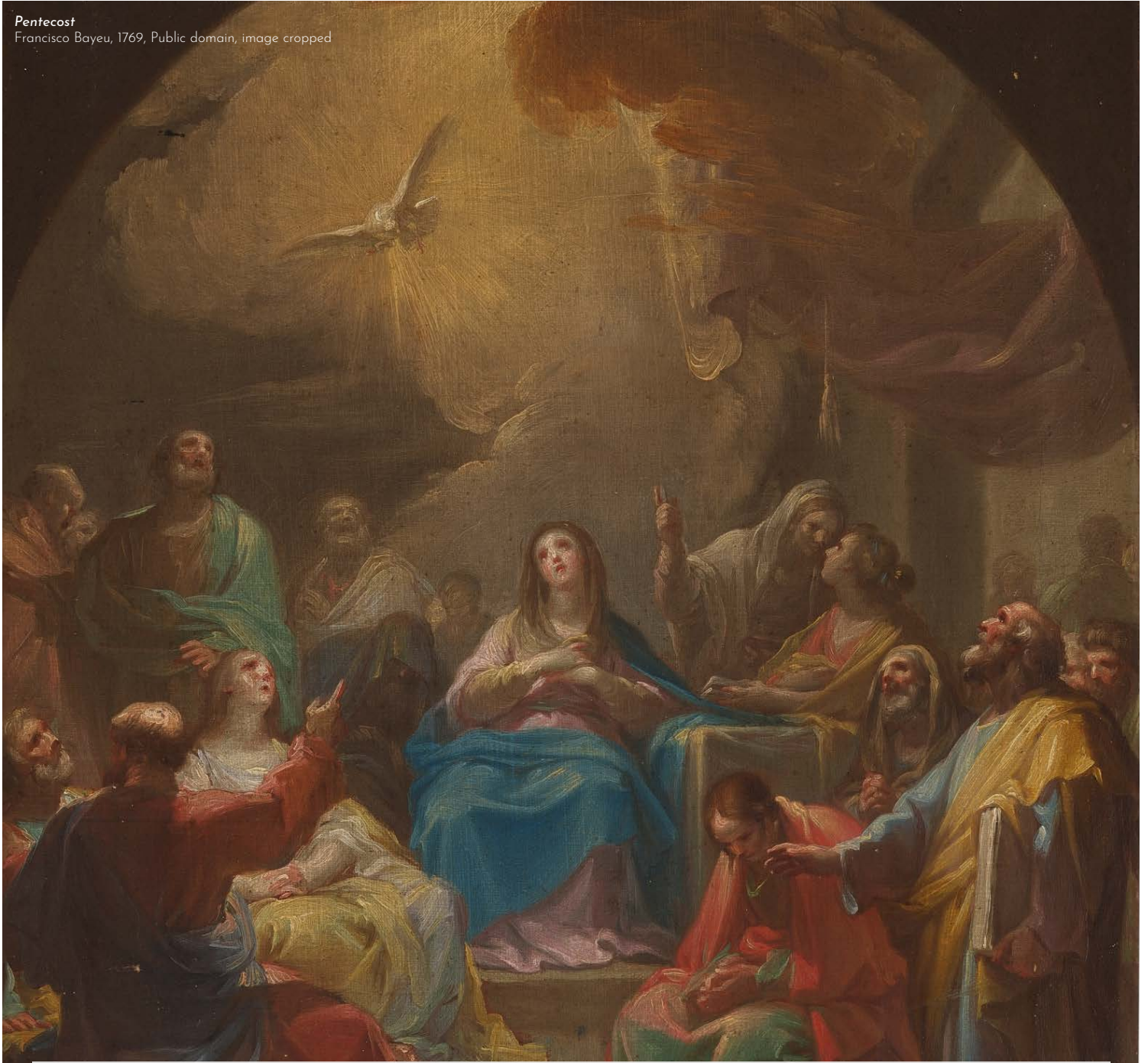

The Most Wonderful Time of the Year

Last week, we had our **Parish Mission with Fr. Leo Patalinghug**. What an experience! I could gush about the mission for pages upon pages, but I'll share a handful of highlights:

1. Preparation – Our staff and volunteers did an outstanding job preparing for the event, whether it was the promotional materials, parking lot attendants, hospitality, or selling Fr. Leo's merchandise. Kudos to everyone who participated, especially to our Evangelization Team of Angie Soules, Denise Sheipline, Lori Wilson, Lisa Fullenkamp, and Pam Roesser.
 2. Turnout – This was the hottest ticket in town (not that you needed tickets). You showed up in droves. On Monday night, there were 817 people present and St. Joseph "holds" 530 people. Fr. Leo made multiple comments about how proud we should be of our parishioners, their faith, and their responsiveness to God's invitation.
 3. Become a Saint – As a French author once said, "the only failure in life is not to become a saint." Fr. Leo reminded us of our vocation to holiness and the role of the Eucharist and the Blessed Virgin Mary in this journey.
 4. Unity – It truly felt like a single parish community. The way that parishioners, who normally attend Mass at different churches, interacted with one another was moving. Overhearing conversations of faith, joy, and prayer lifted my heart to the Lord.
 5. Joy – The Mission was full of laughter, smiles, and hope. At the Last Supper, Jesus tells His disciples, "Be of good cheer, I have overcome the world." We lived this last week.
- We don't want this powerful Mission to be a "one and done" event. We are hoping and praying that the seeds

planted through the Mission and Fr. Leo's preaching will grow and blossom. This fruit will grow over the coming weeks, months, and years. Please pray for Fr. Leo as he boldly preaches the Good News of Jesus Christ. Pray that the Lord sustains his immense work.

Please pray for our sophomores who are receiving the **Sacrament of Confirmation** this Sunday, April 6. The Lord wants to use them to be saints; He is calling them to holiness. May they respond to the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Also I want to formally invite you to our **Holy Week Liturgies**. Next weekend, we celebrate Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion. Please check the schedule in the bulletin. One new item is that Fr. Hoying and David Morand are organizing the **Stations of the Cross with the veneration of a relic of the true Cross on Good Friday** at 7pm at St. Lawrence Church. It should be a powerful experience.

Finally, I announced this at St. Lawrence and Immaculate Conception last weekend, but it is probably good to mention it here. Tim Alley, our Director of Music at those two churches, has stepped aside from his role. He has been battling some health issues and isn't able to commit to this role. Please keep Tim and his family in your prayers.

We are working on covering the weekend Masses for the next two months and then we'll find a more stable solution for the music. Please pray that God sends the right person for us!

Fast & Abstinence Reminders

Good Friday, April 18 is a day of abstinence from meat and also a day of fast, that is, limited to a single full meal. The other Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence from meat. The law of abstinence binds all Catholics 14 years and older. The law of fasting binds all Catholics from their 18th birthday until their 59th birthday (canons 97, 1252). "Let the paschal fast be kept sacred. Let it be celebrated everywhere on Good Friday and, where possible, prolonged throughout Holy Saturday, so that the joys of the Sunday of the Resurrection may be attained with uplifted and clear mind." (Constitution on the Liturgy, No. 110)

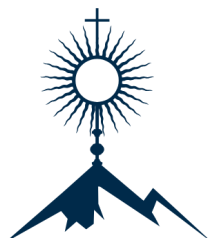

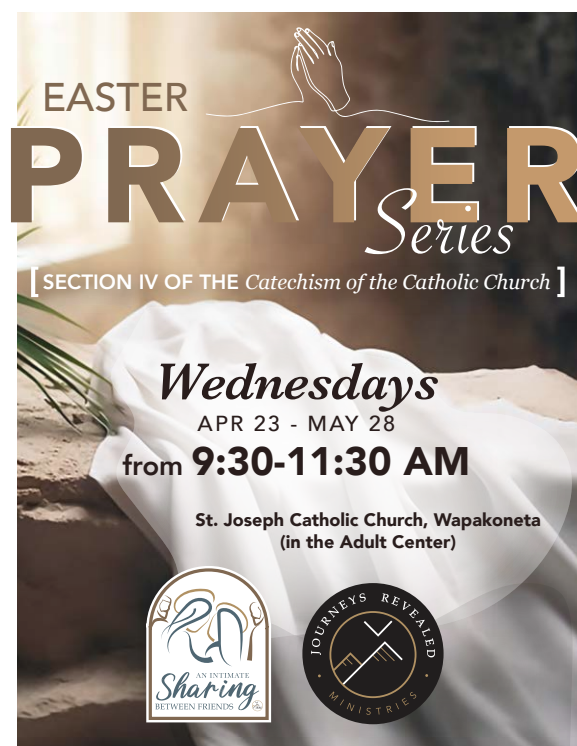
Quo Vadis Night

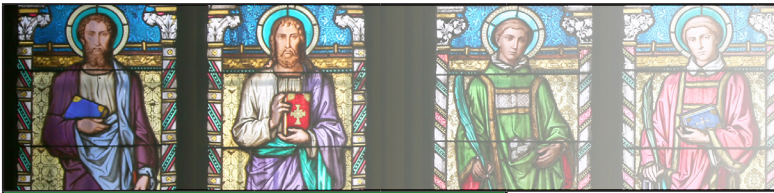

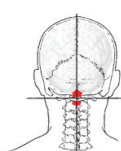
