

There have been recent changes in the music ministry at our parish. Tim Alley resigned from his position as music director at St. Lawrence and Immaculate Conception several weeks ago. Additionally, Adam Fahncke is currently on paternity leave from St. John and St. Joseph following the birth of his child during Holy Week.

We have a team of musicians covering the various Masses. Thank you to David Morand, Dawn Buehler, Louise Westbay, Eli Kentner, and Ian Keller for their contributions. Nate Hanson will join us after his college term ends to assist at Immaculate Conception and St. Lawrence. Thanks to Fr. Hoying for handling scheduling, music planning, and communication. Lastly, thank you to our cantors for adapting to different organists.

I am pleased to announce that Anthony Moeder will return as the Director of Music for Immaculate Conception and St. Lawrence starting July 1, 2025. He previously served in this role for nearly a year before working at St. John the Baptist in Maria Stein and Precious Blood in Chickasaw. Until then, visiting musicians will accompany the Masses. Please join me in welcoming Anthony back.

There are a couple of other staff changes to communicate. Last year, there was a full-time

opening for an Administrative Assistant to support our Evangelization team. As the year progressed, it was decided to have two part-time assistants instead. Pam Roesser has been in one of these positions since last summer. At the end of May, Collette Knutzen will begin as the other Administrative Assistant. We are blessed to have both of them.

At the conclusion of the Easter Vigil, I announced that this will be Lisa Fullenkamp's final year overseeing our RCIA program. She has been instrumental in guiding new Catholics for decades and will commence her retirement in June. Lisa has dedicated over 41 years to Church ministry, contributing not only to the RCIA program but also leading marriage preparation, baptismal preparation, and serving as a school secretary at St. Joseph School. Her presence will be greatly missed, as she has consistently demonstrated warmth and joy. We trust that many have had the opportunity to witness her compassion and peaceful nature.

With Lisa's retirement and the vacancy in the high school youth ministry that has persisted for over a year, we are actively working to recruit two additional team members. We are currently conducting interviews with potential candidates. Please pray that God will send workers into His vineyard.

Rose Sale to Support Right to Life







If you engage with the scammer, they will likely ask for iTunes gift cards. This is not our priests! They will never send messages like this. If you're ever questioning a message, please call the parish office before responding. If you've been scammed, ignore the message (or report it as a "phishing message") and say a prayer for the scammer.


