

### Mission and an Anniversary

\\\\\/ e are blessed by Archbishop Casey's presence this weekend during the 4pm Mass at Immaculate Conception. May the Lord continue to sustain him in his ministry.

Next weekend, we begin hosting our mission cooperative speaker. Each year, the Archdiocese of Cincinnati assigns each parish a missionary to speak at Masses. We take up a second collection to support their missionary efforts. This event reminds us that we are part of a universal Church which proclaims the Gospel far and wide. We share in the responsibility of the Church by supporting these missionary efforts.

This year, we have been assigned the Sisters of St. Joseph based out of St. Louis, Missouri. Sr. Marianne Nestel will be speaking at Masses the next two weekends. On July 26-27, she'll be at St. John and St. Joseph and on August 2-3, she'll be at Immaculate Conception and St. Lawrence. We are excited to welcome her to our parish.

This week, the Church celebrates NFP Awareness Week, which always coincides with July 25, the anniversary of a 1968 papal document, Humanae Vitae. Much could be said about this document: its history, its teachings, and its impact. The document re-affirmed the Church's longstanding teaching about married love, responsible parenthood, and the rejection of artificial contraception. This was a landmark document which was widely criticized.

The document was prophetic. After the discussion of the Church's teaching, it made three predictions if the

use of contraception spread throughout the Church and world. I'll let you judge if Pope Paul VI's three 1968 predictions have come to fruition. He predicted:

- 1. Marital infidelity will increase and there will be a general lowering of moral standards.
- 2. "Men may forget the reverence due to a woman, and, disregarding her physical and emotional equilibrium, reduce her to being a mere instrument for the satisfaction of his own desires"
- 3. "The danger of this power passing into the hands of those public authorities who care little for the precepts of the moral law... Who will prevent public authorities from favoring those contraceptive methods which they consider more effective? Should they regard this as necessary, they may even impose their use on everyone."

These quotes are just a small snippet of the Church's rich teaching on married love. To unpack what the Church teaches about married love and human sexuality, I recently recorded four 30-minute podcast episodes to share the Church's incredible vision for human sexuality. Many Catholics are not aware of the beautiful vision that lesus Christ has for married love. Here is a QR code that will send you to the first podcast

episode. Sometimes these are difficult teachings; be assured of my prayers for all married couples.


#### St. John 175th Anniversary & Homecoming



#### Scammers

Please be aware that scammers have been known to impersonate our priests with a text/email that says something like: "Hi, please return my text when you get it. I have a favor to ask." "Are you available? I have a request for you to manage discreetly." Their text/email will probably even be signed with the name of one of our priests. If you engage with the scammer, they will likely ask for iTunes gift cards. Our priests will never send messages like this. If you ever question a message, please call the parish office before responding. If you've been scammed, ignore the message (or report it as a "phishing message") and say a prayer for the scammer.
