



### Pro-Life Oratory Contest for Shelby County High School Juniors & Seniors

**When & Where:** Monday, February 24<sup>th</sup> at 6:30pm at St. John's Lutheran Church in Sidney **Prizes:** \$400+, \$250, and \$100 for 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup>. One winner receives an additional \$100 travel stipend for participating in the state contest

**Eligibility:** All high school juniors and seniors who are residents of Shelby County or attend a Shelby County high school. Contestants are to give a pro-life speech, 5-7 minutes in length, on one of four topics: abortion, doctor-prescribed suicide, infanticide, or embryonic research.
