## Update on the Archbishop and St. Vincent de Paul

s you probably remember, late last spring, Archbishop Schnurr was diganosed with cancer. Over the last half of 2024, he underwent various treatments. He maintained a relatively full schedule considering that he is 76 years old and battling cancer. His perseverance through it all has been encouraging.

In December, the priests and deacons of the Archdiocese received a letter from the Archbishop that I would like to share with you:

Our Lord has blessed me with a great gift this Christmas season. As you know, these past few months I have undergone twelve rounds of chemotherapy as treatment for Stage 3 bowel cancer. Yesterday afternoon, I met with my oncologist who had reviewed the results of my post treatment testing. He stated, "All the results are favorable." Praise God! My doctor wants to see me every three months for the next year "just to keep an eye on things."

Words cannot adequately express the depth of my gratitude for your prayers during my treatment. From the bottom of my heart thank you. Please continue to pray for me and know of my prayers for you.

Thank you for your prayers for Archbishop Schnurr.

In other news, there will be some upcoming changes to the St. Vincent de Paul ministry in the parish. For the last few years, the ministry has been under the umbrella of a "special outreach" of our regional St. Vincent de Paul (SVdP) based out of Dayton. After reviewing our local outreach ministry, the regional

office asked for our ministry to be reclassified as a normal parish conference of St. Vincent de Paul.

For various reasons, those in the ministry did not believe this would work for our current ministry. Therefore, the St. Vincent de Paul ministry decided to disaffiliate from the regional St. Vincent de Paul ministry and come under the umbrella of the Holy Face of Jesus Parish. All their activities will remain the same. They will still offer assistance for rent, utilities, and other expenses for the poor and needy.

A couple of things will change. First, we'll have to change the name. It will now be known as the Society of the Good Samaritan. The full transition from a SVdP outreach center to a ministry of the parish will happen by June 30. Another change is on the administrative end; the Society of the Good Samaritan will utilize the parish tax number instead of the regional SVdP. The pink monthly collection envelopes reflect the name change.

Thank you for your continued support of this ministry. The leaders of the Society of the Good Samaritan regularly mention how blessed they are by the generosity of our parishioners. ## Word of God Sunday




