Get Your Hard Hats

ver the past few years, we have identified major capital improvement projects at each of our campuses. Some of these projects haven't begun and others are partially completed. With the merger in the Holy Face of Jesus Parish, we need to decide which projects to prioritize and how each project will be funded.

On Monday, November 11, our pastoral council, finance committee, and buildings and grounds committee met together to discuss these matters. Here is the brief recap of the meeting.

The first item to note is that God has blessed us financially. There is no other way around it. We have been entrusted with so much from God and it is a little overwhelming to see His generosity. You have been incredibly generous as well. Hopefully, you noted this in September when we published our annual financial report. Since our fiscal year ended on June 30, 2024 and we merged, we have been blessed in greater ways. We have received a couple of generous estate gifts and a generous pledge toward the renovation of the Faith Center at St. Joseph. With this pledge, we have around \$5.4 million dollars in savings.

We don't want to deplete all our savings on capital improvement projects. The finance committee recommended keeping six months worth of expenses in savinas, about \$1 million.

The biggest project is the Faith Center at St. Joseph. Bids from general contractors were due on October 31, and by the publication of this article, we will have likely selected a contractor. Once a general contractor is officially selected, we can communicate more details about the renovation of the Faith Center.

The stained-glass windows at St. Lawrence Church and St. John Church need to be refurbished. We replaced the exterior storm windows of the St. Lawrence windows over the summer. The windows at St. John are a little smaller than St. Lawrence and less expensive. To complete the

stained-alass windows at St. Lawrence Church, it will cost \$169,000, and to complete the windows at St. John Church, it will cost \$180,000.

The last project is the pipe organ at Immaculate Conception. A committee has been formed to analyze potential solutions and we are diligently researching possibilities. Solutions range from a digital (or electric) organ, which could cost around \$200,000, to a mechanical-action pipe organ, which could cost around \$700,000, but would last ten times as long as a digital organ. We don't have any official bids yet for this project because we aren't sure what we want yet.

The Pastoral Council, Finance Committee, and Buildings and Grounds Committee unanimously recommended to begin the renovation of the Faith Center, refurbish the stained-alass windows at St. Lawrence and St. John, and to allocate \$500,000 for the new pipe organ at Immaculate Conception.

These are major endeavors, and they will be completed over the coming years. Hopefully it builds confidence that we are here to stay. All of our buildings will be maintained and improved.

There are three action items: please pray for the safe completion of these projects. Secondly, if you would like to give to these projects, you can. Simply make a check out to Holy Face of Jesus Parish and include the particular project in the memo line. We'll communicate more fundraising information, but I wanted to communicate this before the end of the year.

Finally, there are numerous details that I wasn't able to include in this article. There will be more information to come. We will have a town hall meeting on Sunday, December 8th at 4pm in the St. Joseph Parish Life Center. If you are not able to come, it will be recorded and posted online.


