

A Visit from Friends

ach year, on the first Sunday of January we celebrate the visit of the Magi to Jesus, Mary, and Joseph in Bethlehem. These Wise Men traversed afar to offer gifts and to worship the Newborn King in the city of David, Bethlehem.

Each year, we are visited by friends who come from Bethlehem. The Bethlehem wood carvers will again be visiting next weekend, February 22-23. They come to share a little bit of the story of Christians in the Middle East and to sell their hand-carved olive wood products. You probably remember the beauty and craftmanship with which each piece is made, whether a cross, statue, or nativity scene.

Thank you for your generosity in supporting the Bethlehem wood carvers. As you can imagine, these past 16 months have been extremely difficult for Christians in the Holy Land. They are caught between different religious groups and various forms of violence. Most of the Christians in the Holy Land sustain themselves through tourism, welcoming pilgrims and supporting their needs. Unfortunately this hasn't happened for over a year. The situation is sad for our brothers and sisters who live near the holiest sites of our Lord Jesus Christ's life, death, and resurrection.

Thank you for your financial support and your prayers for the Christians in the Holy Land.

In other news, we are nearing Ash Wednesday on March 5th, so it is time to begin thinking and praying about Lent. Ask God what His plans are for your Lent. How does He want you to increase in prayer, fasting, and generosity? Certainly God has a plan for your Lent.

Please mark down a couple things in your calendar. We'll have another retreat luncheon on Thursday, March 13th from 11:30am to 1:30pm. This will be a great opportunity for those who are free during the day to have a great lunch, meet new friends, and learn a little bit about their Catholic faith. Last fall's luncheon was a great success with over 80 attendees. Feel free to invite a friend or neighbor. The topic this time is the Jubilee Year.

Also, we'll have our parish mission March 30-April 1. There will be evening activities and events beginning with the Rosary at 5:30pm each night. Fr. Leo Patalinghug will offer three different talks in the evening. It should be a great time of renewal.

In completely other news, the work on the stained glass windows at St. Lawrence has begun. Windows Creations will be removing two windows at a time to refurbish them.

Finally, the work on the Faith Center will begin on February 24. This weekend is the "Take and Donate." Times are in the bulletin. Please pray for all those who'll be working on this project and for their safety. They are hoping to complete the project in January 2026.

Fast & Abstinence Reminders

Ash Wednesday, March 5 and Good Friday, April 18 are days of abstinence from meat and also days of fast, that is, limited to a single full meal. The other Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence from meat. The law of abstinence binds all Catholics 14 years and older. The law of fasting binds all Catholics from their 18th birthday until their 59th birthday (canons 97, 1252). "Let the paschal fast be kept sacred. Let it be celebrated everywhere on Good Friday and, where possible, prolonged throughout Holy Saturday, so that the joys of the Sunday of the Resurrection may be attained with uplifted and clear mind." (Constitution on the Liturgy, No. 110)
