

In other news, please put something on your calendar. Archbishop Robert Casey will be celebrating Mass at Immaculate Conception in Botkins on Saturday, July 19th at the 4pm Mass. He is coming to celebrate the Catholic Ministries Appeal (CMA) Mass of Thanksgiving. Every summer the archbishop travels to different parts of the diocese to thank God for the numerous donations the archdiocese receives. This also gives Archbishop Casev an opportunity to meet people from the archdiocese. Mass shouldn't take any longer than usual; Archbishop Casey isn't known to preach long.

Thank you to everyone who supported and volunteered at the Fourth of July Festival. It takes hours and hours to prepare, operate, and clean up from the festival. - 3. Hungry people have the opportunity to eat fresh, nutritious food!

Plant a Row for the Hungry programs exist across the United States. Plant a Row is organized locally by the social justice collaborative, Fields of Justice. Fields of Justice includes individuals and representatives of parish families in the northern part of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. Its efforts serve people of all faiths.

Tips:


If you have a large amount of produce, please call in advance to let the food bank know that you are coming. No rotten produce—if you can't eat it, pantry clients cannot eat it! Offer only good quality, freshly-picked produce to food pantries.

Handle fresh fruits and vegetables safely to minimize the risk of foodborne illness.

Don't mix produce types. Keep each type in separate, clean containers or bags.

Clean as much mud and dirt as possible off of the produce you plan to donate.

Choose produce without mold, spoilage, bruising, or insects.

Scammers

Please be aware that scammers have been known to impersonate our priests with a text/email that says something like: "Hi please return my text when you get it. I have a favor to ask." "Are you available? I have a request for you to manage discreetly." Their text/email will probably even be signed with the name of one of our priests. If you engage with the scammer, they will likely ask for iTunes gift cards. Our priests will never send messages like this. If you're ever questioning a message, please call the parish office before responding. If you've been scammed, ignore the message (or report it as a "phishing message") and say a prayer for the scammer.


