# Introducing Fr. Hoying



Hello! I have already shared a little of my story in my homilies, but please allow me to introduce myself a little more fully. I am Fr. Ethan Hoying (I go by Fr. Hoying), and I am so very glad to be here. I am so thankful for the warm welcome which I have received from the moment

I set foot in Holy Face of Jesus Parish a couple of weeks ago. I have been blown away by your kindness! Thank you!

I was raised on a small family farm in Russia, OH. My parents are Mark and Gina (Grillot) Hoying. My dad is an engineer and works at Midmark in Versailles. My mom is a homemaker and enjoys babysitting my nieces and nephews. I am the second of four children. My older brother, Jacob, married Taylor Rittenhouse of Russia. They have 5 children: Ivy, Miah, Isaac, Maci, and Miles. My younger brother, Adam, married Breanna Schulze of St. Henry, and they have 2 girls: Abigail and Rita. Jacob is a physical therapist at Wilson in Sidney, and Adam is an engineer at Midmark. My youngest sibling is my sister Rachel, who is a junior at the Wright State Lake Campus. I actually live the farthest since they all still live in Russia!

My grandparents are Marion and Emily Grillot (both dec'd.) of Russia. Grandpa was orphaned at a young age, but I remember him telling stories about Fr. Tebbe, who brought him great comfort as a familiar face from his boyhood years on the farm. Fr. Tebbe convalesced painting murals at St. Joseph Orphanage in Cincinnati during Grandpa's stay there. Grandpa and Grandma had

twenty children of which my mom is number nineteen. Her older brother is Andy Grillot, who was married to Becky Metz of Botkins. My dad's parents are Francis (dec'd) and Leola Hoying of Russia. Grandma's mom was raised here in Rhine and her great-grandparents are buried in the cemetery. Grandpa was from nearby St. Patrick's (McCartyville) and loved the surrounding area, much like me.

I consider myself an outdoorsman. I love hiking, gardening, cutting firewood, going kayaking, just about doing anything outdoors really. Of course, any chance I get I love slipping out to my parent's farm just to tinker around. Lately, I've been clearing fencerows with my dad and brothers. I also enjoy watching movies, sitting around a campfire, and sharing a meal and good conversation. After graduating from Russia School in 2013, I went straight into college seminary at the Pontifical College Josephinum in Columbus, OH. Upon graduation from there, I attended Mount St. Mary's Seminary and School of Theology in Cincinnati. I was ordained in May 2022 along with my classmate, Fr. Willig. Prior to coming here, I served in the Coldwater and Ft. Recovery family of parishes.

As I've said already, I am glad to be here, but I also know what my coming means. It's hard to see a good priest, like Fr. Willig, move on to another assignment. Since Fr. Willig is a friend of mine, and since I like and respect him so much, of course I'm pleased if you do too. I won't be able to fill his shoes, but I'm happy to follow such a good priest. Like Fr. Willig and Fr. Sean, my one goal is to get to Heaven and to bring you with me!

Again, it's great to be here, and I look forward to getting to know you and your families!
