## Angels We Have Heard on High

Today, September 29th, would normally be the Feast day of the **Archangels**, Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael. However, since it falls on Sunday, the feast day is omitted this year. Nonetheless, we can still thank God for the presence of the angels. They are our constant helpers and protectors. If you want to learn a little more about how angels help us, read the Book of Tobit. The Angel Raphael features prominently in this book.

October 2 is also the Feast of the **Guardian Angels**. As St. Basil states, "beside each believer stands an angel as protector and shepherd leading him to life" (quoted in the Catechism of the Catholic Church, 336). The Guardian Angels protect us from harm and lead us on in our life. It is probably a good idea to thank God for our Guardian Angel on October 2. Only at the end of our life will we know how much guidance and protection they offer us.

In addition, this week is the Feast Day of **St. Thérèse of the Child Jesus and the Holy Face**. I mentioned last week how this became the patronal feast of our parish. Not only will the feast day be celebrated on Tuesday, October 1, but we are able to move her feast day to a nearby Sunday. On October 5 and 6, we'll celebrate the Feast of St. Thérèse. There will be coffee and doughnuts after the Sunday Masses.

On that same weekend, I'll be out of town for **vacation**. I'm departing Friday, October 4 and returning Friday, October 11 to visit my family in Georgia. I thought about cancelling it with all the transitions taking place, however, my niece and nephew are out of school for their fall break and I'm covering Sunday Mass at my family's parish. Their pastor is the only priest in the

county and he struggles to find Mass coverage so that he can take a vacation. I am a little disappointed to miss Fr. Willig's final week in the parish, but that is just the way it goes. Don't have too much fun without me.

We will have a going away party for Fr. Willig on Sunday, October 13 from 1pm to 3pm in the Immaculate Conception basement. Everyone is welcome to attend. It will be a great opportunity to thank Fr. Willig for his service and to wish him the best in his new important role. If you are able, please drop by.

To come back to the opening theme of angels, I repeat what was said in Bethlehem 2,000 years ago, "I proclaim to you good news of great joy that will be for all the people" (Luke 2:10). Archbishop Schnurr has appointed **Fr. Ethan Hoying** to be the new parochial vicar at our parish. Originally from Russia, OH, Fr. Hoying was ordained in 2022 with Fr. Willig and he has served the Holy Cross Family of Parishes in the Coldwater and Fort Recovery area. We are extremely blessed by this appointment. Fr. Hoying is a wonderful man and a great priest. He will begin in our parish on Monday, October 14. Please join me in welcoming him and praying for him.

## HOLY FACE RETREAT LUNCHEON


