

The Epiphany of the Lord

Today, we celebrate the Epiphany of the Lord. The word epiphany is a fancy way to say "manifestation" or "revelation." Jesus was "revealed" as the Lord by the guidance of the star. The magi (or wise men) visited our Lord's home and offered him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh.

Traditionally the blessing of homes accompanies the Feast of the Epiphany. You can ask a priest or deacon to bless your home or a member of the family can lead the home blessing.

Leader: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. **All:** Amen

Leader: Our help is in the name of the Lord. **All:** Who made heaven and earth.

Read the story of Zaccheus, Luke 19:1-9.

The intercessions are said by the leader or someone else. The response is Stay with us, Lord.

Lord Jesus Christ, with Mary and Joseph you formed the Holy Family: remain in our home, that we may know you as our guest and honor you as our head. We pray: R.

Lord Jesus Christ, through you every dwelling is a temple of holiness: build those who live in this house into the dwelling place of God in the Holy Spirit. We pray: R.

Lord Jesus Christ, you taught your followers to build their houses upon solid rock: grant that the members of this family may live their lives in firm allegiance to your teachings. We pray: R.

Lord Jesus Christ, you had no place to lay your head, but in the spirit of poverty accepted the hospitality of your friends: grant that through our help the homeless may obtain proper housing. We pray: R.

Lord Jesus Christ, you became flesh of the Virgin Mary: grant that your presence may be known always in this home. We pray: R.

Lord Jesus Christ, the three kings presented their gifts to you in praise and adoration: grant that those living in this house may use their talents and abilities to your greater glory. We pray: R.

Pray together the Our Father

Leader: Lord God of heaven and earth, you revealed your only-begotten Son to every nation by the guidance of a star. Bless this house and all who inhabit it. Fill them with the light of Christ, that their concern for others may reflect your love. We ask this through Christ our Lord. **All:** Amen.

Traditionally, an inscription is written in chalk over the front door. The inscription is:

20 + C + M + B + 25

The numbers on the end represent the year (20 25). The letters C M B have two different meanings. The names of the three magi: Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar. Or the Latin phrase *Christus mansionem benedicat* which means "Christ bless this house."

May you have a blessed feast of the Epiphany of the Lord.

Pick up a piece of blessed chalk at the doors of any of our churches during January, and bless your home! The ritual calls for a "leader" to mark with chalk the inside of the door with the initials of the Magi (Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar) and a code of the current year connected with crosses: **20+C+M+B+25** Pray this together as a family. Start with your main entrance, and repeat at other doors. On

the lintel, the leader writes the code and says: **Leader:** (While writing 20 +) In this century of Our

Lord and God

ALL: We honor our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

Leader: (While writing C +) May all who come to our house this year

ALL: find Christ living among us.

Leader: (While writing M +) May our home be a place of faith...

ALL: A dwelling of goodness, love and peace.

Leader: (While writing B +) Bless this house and all who inhabit it.
