

### Jubilee 2025

n Christmas Eve 2024, Pope Francis inaugurated the 2025 Jubilee Year. You may be asking, what is a Jubilee Year? Well I'm glad you asked.

The Jubilee has Old Testament roots in the Book of Leviticus. This book of the Old Testament promulgates the law by which God's people are to live by and it states, "You shall treat this fiftieth year as sacred. You shall proclaim liberty in the land for all its inhabitants. It shall be a jubilee for you, when each of you shall return to your own property, each of you to your own family" (25:10-11). Every fifty years, God's people celebrated the jubilee year. In this year, they reset their relationship with God, each other, and creation. Every fifty years they received a new beginning.

Before the coming of Jesus Christ, the people of God anticipated a Messiah who would proclaim the definitive jubilee (see Isaiah 61:1-2). This was dramatically filled by Jesus in last Sunday's Gospel as He comes "to proclaim a year acceptable to the Lord" (Luke 4:19). Jesus fulfills the Old Testament desire for the great jubilee of mercy, forgiveness, and restoration.

The Church didn't begin celebrating the great Jubilee until 1300, when the Pope offered an indulgence for those who visited Rome during that year. Over the next few centuries, the Church fell into a rhythm of offering a Jubilee year every 25 years. We are blessed that the Church celebrates the Jubilee every 25 years which is twice as often as the people of the Old Testament.

Having a Jubilee every 25 years means that this year is a Jubilee Year. Praise God! Commenting on the Jubilee Year, Pope Francis states, "God's holy and faithful people has experienced this celebration as a special gift of grace, characterized by the forgiveness of sins and in particular by the indulgence, which is a full expression of the mercy of God." The Jubilee Year is a gift from God to us, His beloved people. He wants to shower the fullness of His grace upon us in a special way during this year.

We will be celebrating this fantastic Jubilee in a couple of different ways. First, we will have our first parish mission in over a decade. This will be a time of renewal and transformation for us. Through this mission, it is my hope that we will experience the restoration that can only come from Jesus Christ. May our families and faith be restored.

During this Jubilee Year, we will also be celebrating the anniversary of the dedication of St. John Church in Fryburg. This is the 175th anniversary of its dedication. A committee has planned monthly events associated with the anniversary, so please keep an eye on the bulletin. The first event is a Chili Cookoff on Sunday, February 16th.

I pray that this Jubilee will be a time of healing and restoration for our parishioners. There will be more information about the Jubilee in coming weeks and months. There are indulgences to gain and places of pilgrimage to visit. May the Lord refresh you during this great Jubilee.


