World Marriage Day

This Sunday, February 9th, marks World Marriage Day. It is traditionally observed on the second Sunday of February, close to St. Valentine's Day. Reminders of the upcoming Valentine's Day are prevalent in various retail stores, including Walmart. Like many other special occasions, Valentine's Day has increasingly taken on a commercial aspect. Despite consumerism, Valentine's Day allows couples to appreciate their marriage and thank God for their spouse.

A preliminary inquiry is, "Why is St. Valentine's Day specifically chosen for celebrating marital love?" The straightforward response is that we do not know. Various legends are associated with St. Valentine. Some believe he clandestinely married couples against the Roman Emperor's wishes. Others suggest that St. Valentine cut out hearts from paper to remind men of their wives. Additionally, some have noted that February 14th coincides with the period when medieval observers saw birds selecting their mates. Regardless of how the tradition originated, it is appropriate to honor marital and romantic love on this day.

During the wedding ceremony, after the exchange of vows, the newly married couple receive the Nuptial Blessing. It is an extended blessing asking for God's favor upon them. One of the lines in the blessing is, *Grant, O Lord, that, as they enter upon this sacramental union,*

they may share with one another the gifts of your love and, by being for each other a sign of your presence, become one heart and one mind.

The blessing suggests that married couples can be seen as a sign of the presence of God. This means that married couples reveal God to each other. In their interactions with each other, married couples show each other the love of God.

During the 2025 Jubilee Year, spouses are encouraged to reflect on how God's mercy is manifested through their partners. By offering forgiveness, patiently enduring each other's shortcomings, and facing struggles together, married couples can demonstrate the divine attributes of God to one another. Just as God embodies mercy, kindness, patience, and forgiveness, these qualities can be observed within the dynamics of marital relationships.

On this World Marriage Day during the Jubilee, spouses might reflect on questions such as, "How has my spouse revealed God's mercy to me?" or "What have I learned about God from the virtues and generosity of my spouse?" Let us pray for all married couples. For those who are dating, engaged, or married, there are numerous valuable Catholic marriage resources available at foryourmarriage.org.

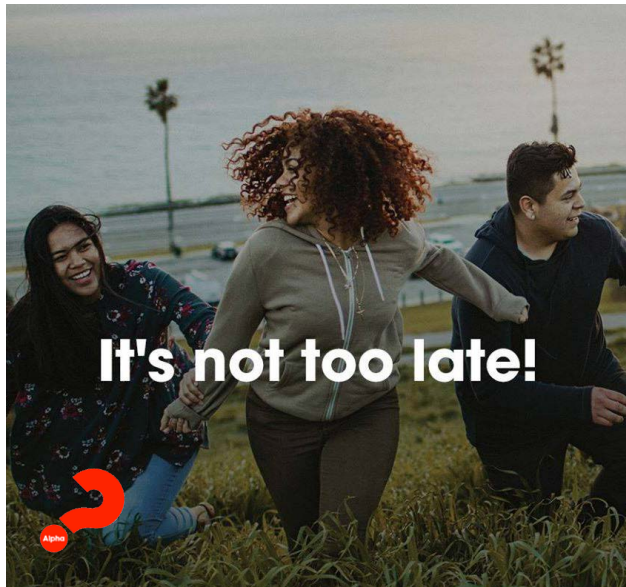

Northwest Men's Conference

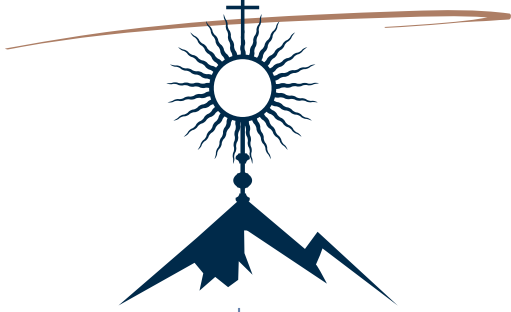
