

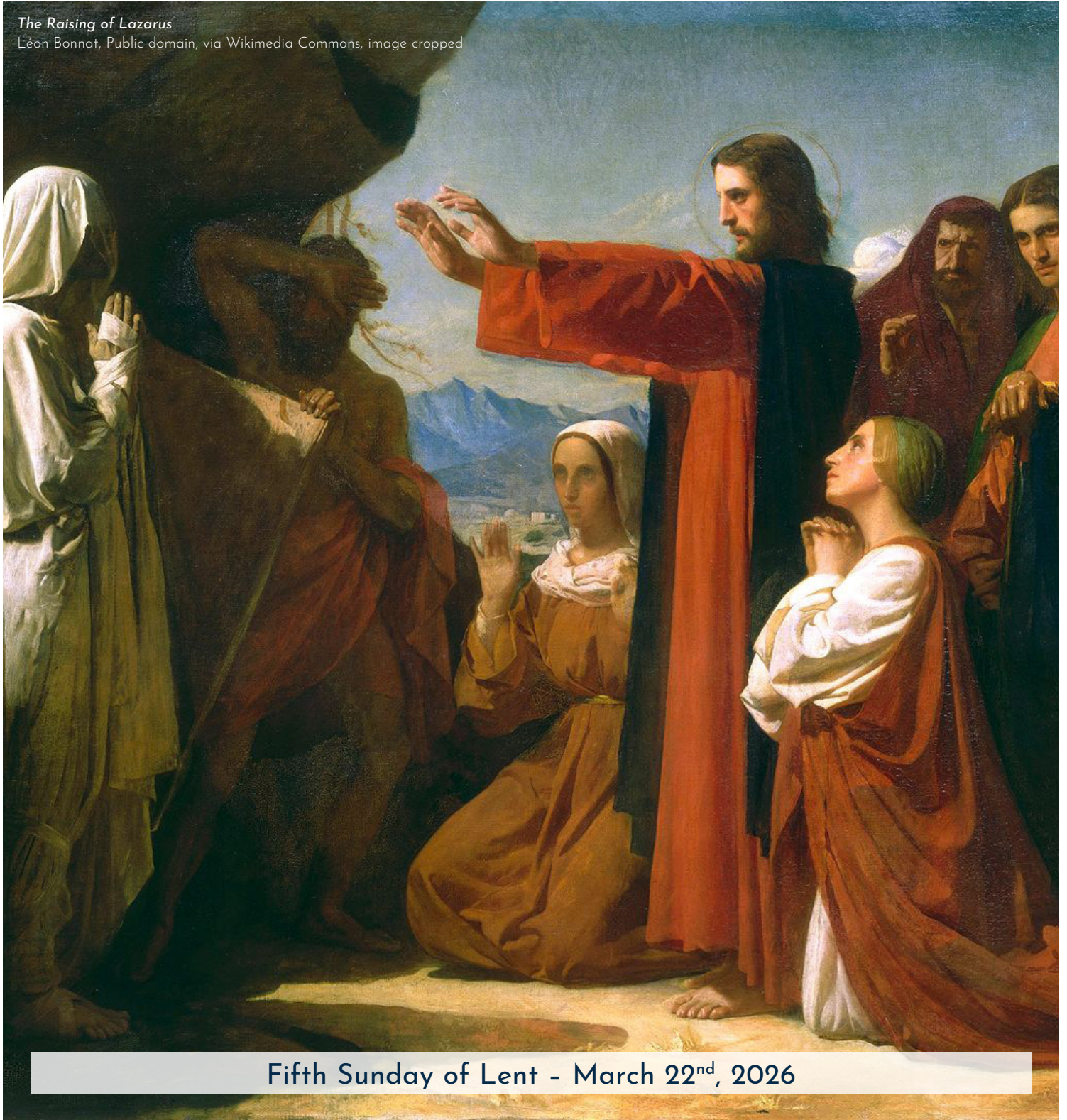

Praying the Angelus

This Wednesday, March 25, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Annunciation. It commemorates the interaction between the angel Gabriel and Mary. Gabriel “announced” that Mary would be with child and Mary gave her “yes” to God through the angel, and Jesus was conceived in her womb. Naturally, this feast day is exactly nine months before Christmas.

This is a major feast day in the Church and I invite you to celebrate in some way, even relaxing your Lenten penances. You could also go to daily Mass, pray the Rosary, stop by the church to pray, or pray the Angelus.

Maybe you have heard of the Angelus. At one point, people would pray the Angelus at 6am, noon, and 6pm every day. This is why church bells ring every day; it reminds people to pray the Angelus at these times.

Normally, the Angelus is prayed with one person leading (V) and everyone else responding (R). Here is the text of the prayer:

V/. The Angel of the Lord declared unto Mary,

R/. And she conceived of the Holy Spirit.

Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with you; blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus.

Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

V/. Behold the handmaid of the Lord,

R/. Be it done unto me according to your Word.

Hail Mary...

V/. And the Word was made flesh,

R/. And dwelt among us.

Hail Mary...

V/. Pray for us, O holy Mother of God,

R/. That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

Let us pray. Pour forth, we beseech You, O Lord, Your grace into our hearts: that we, to whom the Incarnation of Christ Your Son was made known by the message of an Angel, may by His Passion and Cross be brought to the glory of His Resurrection. Through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.

In a beautiful way, the Angelus focuses on the moment God became man (the Incarnation) and recalls Mary's trust and obedience.
