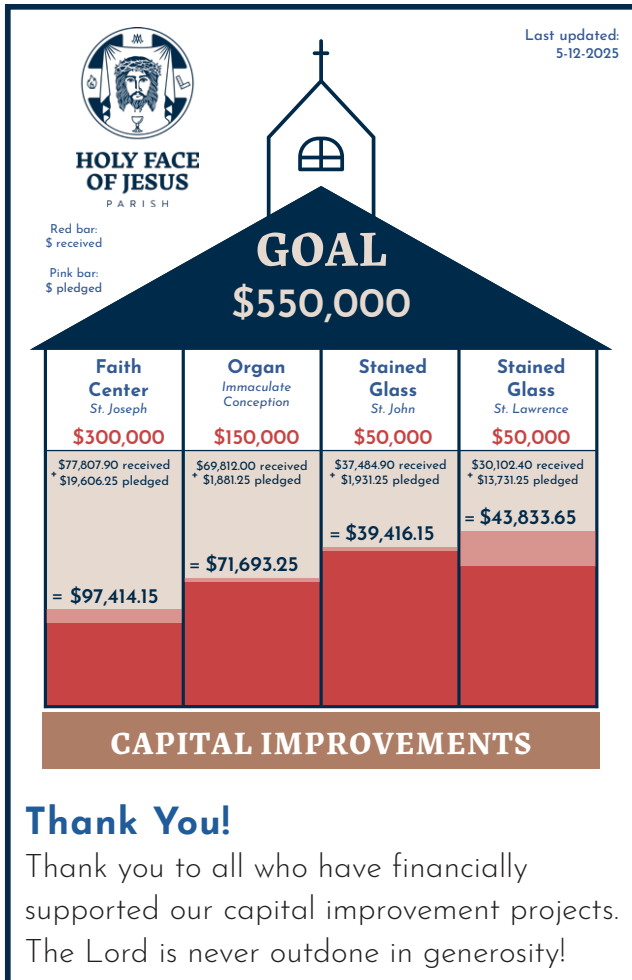

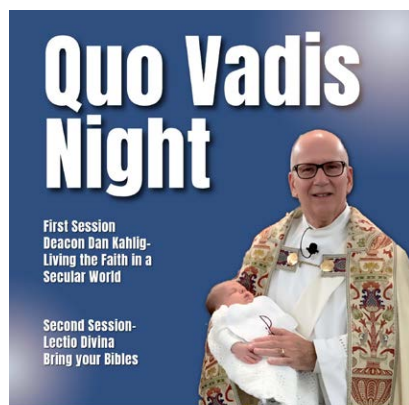

## Rays of Hope: Camp for Kids Dealing with Loss

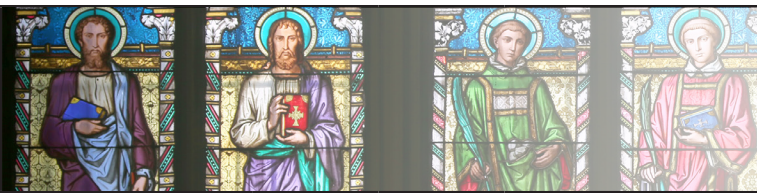

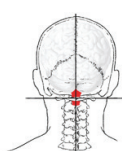
