

Over the past few years, Amelia and her mother, Ashley, cleaned the church. With her graduation, they will step aside from cleaning. Thank you for your years of generous service to the Church. 



If you're ever questioning a message, please call the parish office before responding. If you've been scammed, ignore the message (or report it as a "phishing message") and say a prayer for the scammer.




