

Pastoral Council and More

The Pastoral Council plays a vital role in guiding our parish community, ensuring that we continue to grow in faith and mission. As we prepare for a new term, we invite you to prayerfully consider serving on the council—or nominating a fellow parishioner who would be a good fit.

The council consists of twelve members, three from each church. Members must be at least 19 years old, registered at Holy Face of Jesus Parish, and active in parish life. They should also be willing to listen to parishioners, engage in meaningful discussions, and prayerfully discern the parish's direction. More details on the council's role and responsibilities can be found in the **Pastoral Council Charter**, which is available on the parish website.

If you feel called to serve, or if you know someone who would be a great addition to the council, please submit nominations to **pastor@** holyfaceparish.org by Tuesday, April 8. Elections will take place in the middle of May and the three-year term begins July 1, 2025.

Your participation ensures that our parish remains vibrant, faithful, and responsive to the needs of our community. Please keep this process in

your prayers, asking the Holy Spirit to guide our selections.

We are still in the midst of Lent, which bring many incredible opportunities for growth and transformation. Stations of the Cross happens at Immaculate Conception and St. Joseph on Friday evenings. Also the Holy Hours are at 4:30pm on Sundays at St. Lawrence.

We have a **Day of Grace** at Immaculate Conception on Tuesday, March 18. Confession and Adoration will be available in the Church from 9am to 9pm. Also on Wednesday, March 19 the Church celebrates the **Solemnity of St. Joseph**. There will be an extra Mass at St. Joseph at 7pm to celebrate this great feast day. Many of our CCD students will be present for that Mass as well.

Finally, please mark your calendars for the **parish** mission March 30 - April 1. Fr. Leo Patalinghug will be offering a different talk each night to energize our faith. He is an incredible speaker. There are more details on page 5.



St. Joseph's Table

According to legend, a famine plagued Sicily many centuries ago. The villagers sought St. Joseph's help and their prayers were answered. To mark the end of the suffering, a special feast of thanksgiving was held in commemoration of the Saint. This celebration became tradition. Wealthy families prepared huge buffets, then invited those who were less fortunate, especially the homeless and sick. The practice known as St. Joseph's Table has been carried on to the present, both in Europe and in the United States, especially in communities with a strong Sicilian heritage.

A table covered with fine linens and beautiful flowers is filled with food to share with everyone. Because the celebration occurs during Lent, all the wonderful dishes are meatless. Many offerings feature grains and beans or lentils. Few of us at Holy Face of Jesus Parish can trace our roots to Sicily, yet we can adopt the spirit of generosity exemplified by this tradition. From March 11–March 20, we will create our own Saint Joseph's Table in front of the St. Joseph mural at St. Joseph church. All are invited to make donations of non-perishable items which will be divided between God's Storehouse, Mercy Unlimited, and Fish Pond Food Pantry. If you'd like, your donation can reflect the origins of the festive celebration, such as pasta or cans of beans, tomatoes or other vegetables. Thank you for your generosity!
