

New Life and a New Saint

appy Easter! May the joy of Jesus, risen from the dead, fill you with peace and hope! The powers of darkness have lost their sting as Jesus tramples death. I hope and pray that you experience the power of the Resurrection of Jesus. On behalf of Fr. Hoying, our deacons, staff, and pastoral council, I want to wish everyone a very blessed Easter!

Through His Resurrection from the dead, Jesus opens the gates of paradise for us; He gives us the possibility of heaven. All human beings who are in heaven are known as saints. Saints aren't just the people in stained glass windows or on holy cards, but they are people who have blazed the trail of salvation. Some of them are officially recognized by the Church as saints, people who are confirmed as being in heaven.

Next Sunday, April 27th, the Church celebrates the canonization of a new saint, Carlo Acutis. He will be canonized by Pope Francis during a Mass in Rome and it will likely be streamed and aired on EWTN.

If you want to learn even more about the soon-to-be St. Carlo Acutis, there is a new movie about him. It will be showing three nights only, next week: Sun. April 27, Mon. April 28, and Tue. April 29. Locally, it will be showing at the movie theaters in Lima and Piqua.

If you remember, about 26 months ago, a relic of St. Carlo Acutis traveled the United States and stopped at our parish for a week. We had a Eucharistic Festival to commemorate the event. It was a spectacular event and we welcomed visitors from across the state to learn about Eucharistic miracles and venerate his relic.

St. Carlo is a remarkable saint. He was born on May 3, 1991, in London, England, and raised in Milan, Italy. From a young age, he displayed a deep devotion to his Catholic faith, attending daily Mass and praying the Rosary regularly. He had a particular love for the Eucharist, which he called his "highway to heaven." Carlo was also passionate about technology and used his skills to create a website documenting Eucharistic miracles worldwide, aiming to spread awareness of the presence of Christ in the Eucharist. During our Eucharistic Festival, we displayed the Eucharistic miracles that he researched.

Despite his youth, Carlo lived with remarkable maturity, kindness, and a strong sense of purpose. He believed in using his talents to serve others and often

helped his peers, especially those struggling with faith. His life was tragically cut short when he was diagnosed with leukemia at the age of 15. Even in his suffering, he remained steadfast in his faith, saying, "I am happy to die because I have lived my life without wasting a minute on those



things which do not please God."

Happy Easter! May you experience the joy of Jesus, like St. Carlo Acutis.

Precepts of the Catholic Church

See Catechism of the Catholic Church, paragraphs 2041–2043

- 1. You shall attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation and rest from servile labor.
 - Requires the faithful to participate in the Eucharistic celebration when the Christian community gathers together on the day commemorating the Resurrection of the Lord.
- 2. You shall confess your sins at least once a year.
 - Ensures preparation for the Eucharist by the reception of the Sacrament of Reconciliation, which continues Baptism's work of conversion and forgiveness.
- 3. You shall humbly receive your Creator in Holy Communion at least once a year during the Easter season.

Guarantees as a minimum, the reception of the Lord's Body and Blood in connection with the Paschal feasts, the origin and center of the Christian liturgy.

- 4. You shall observe the prescribed days of fasting and abstinence established by the Church.
 - Ensures the times of ascesis and penance which prepare us for the liturgical feasts and help us acquire mastery over our instincts and freedom of heart.
- 5. You shall provide for the needs of the Church.

The faithful are obliged to assist with the material needs of the Church, each according to his own ability.



Please be aware that scammers have been known to impersonate our priests. They may send a text/email that says something like: "Hi, please return my text when you get it. I have a favor to ask." "Are you available? I have a request for you to manage discreetly." Their text or email will probably even be signed with the name of one of our priests. If you engage with the scammer, they will likely ask for iTunes gift cards. This is not our priests! They will never send messages like this. If you're ever questioning a message, please call the parish office before responding. If you've been scammed, ignore the message (or report it as a "phishing message") and say a prayer for the scammer.




