

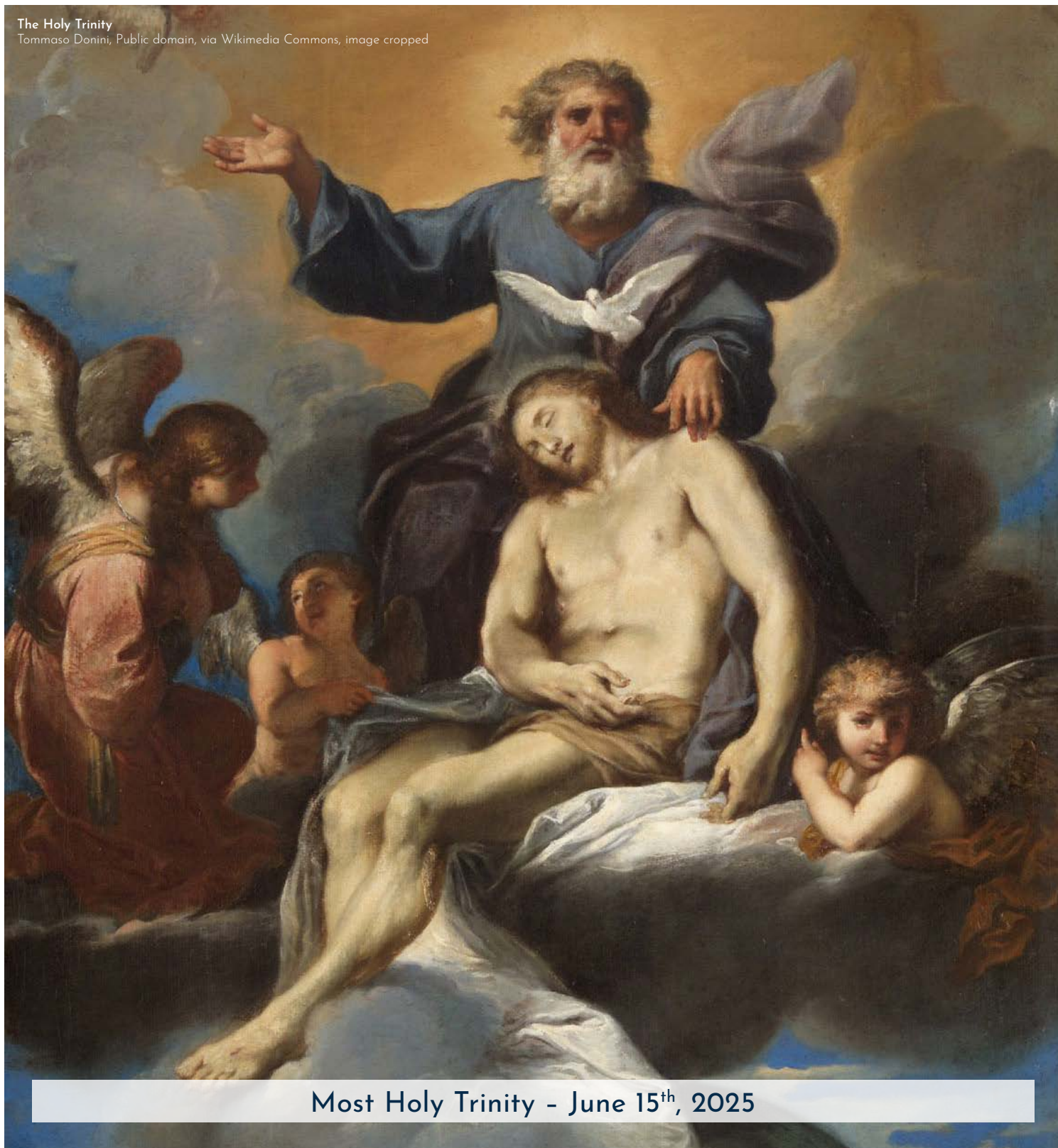

Summertime

Happy Father's Day and Trinity Sunday. Today we recall the mystery of the Triune God and the concrete love of our earthly fathers. God is love and fatherhood is wrapped up in the love of children as well. May all our dads be abundantly blessed.

Next Sunday we celebrate Corpus Christi Sunday during which we commemorate Jesus' gift of the Eucharist. We'll be having our annual Corpus Christi Procession and this year it will look a little different. In conjunction with the 2025 Jubilee Year, we'll be making a parish pilgrimage to the Shrine of the Holy Relics in Maria Stein. The shrine has been designated as a pilgrimage location for the Jubilee Year in our Archdiocese. We'll be having a Eucharistic Procession while we are there. Details are on page 5 of the bulletin.

To follow up on last week's bulletin and some of the rearranging of ministries at the parish, I have a few more details. Angie Soules will be the point person for people becoming Catholic, so if you or someone you know is interested in becoming Catholic, she'll be the point of contact. Also, she'll be the point of contact for our Witness to Love marriage preparation program and our Engaged Couples Retreat. Engaged couples can still reach out to their priest or deacon with questions about the process in general or planning the wedding ceremony.

Finally, people have been asking me about any summer plans I have, and I thought that I would go ahead and answer here. I have two things planned. First my family will be meeting at my younger brother's house in Connecticut in the middle of July. My brother and his family live ten minutes from the beach and we are looking forward to the visit.

Also I haven't taken my annual retreat this year, so I plan

to do that. I had the week before my family vacation scheduled for retreat and tossed around a couple different places to go for retreat. The Jubilee Year really excited me. I decided to make a quick retreat in Rome for the Jubilee Year. I'll leave after Sunday Mass on July 6 and return five days later, on Friday, July 11. I don't plan on doing any vacation type things: no long meals, no souvenir shopping, no museums. It will be a retreat and pilgrimage: lots of walking and praying. I'm going by myself and found a guesthouse with a chapel at which to stay.

I am blessed to have an opportunity to do this. I wish everyone could go to Rome for the 2025 Jubilee Year. I want to take your petitions with me. You can use the QR code here to submit petitions for me to take with me to Rome. Please submit petitions online by **July 6th**. Alternatively, you can put your petitions in a marked envelope in the collection by **June 29th**, or drop them off at the parish office by **June 30th**. I'll be sure to pray for them at the tombs of the saints in Rome. Please pray for me and I'll be praying for all of you.



Finally, Fr. Hoying will be on vacation for the next two weeks. All his vacation was crammed into the end of the year: the Rome pilgrimage, the workshop at the seminary in June (not really vacation, but mandatory ongoing formation), and this vacation. He was supposed to be on vacation the first two weeks of his assignment here in October 2024 but cancelled it. Pray that he has a restful time away.

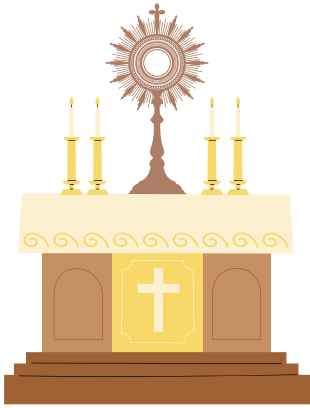
June 5th Pastoral Council Meeting Bullet Points

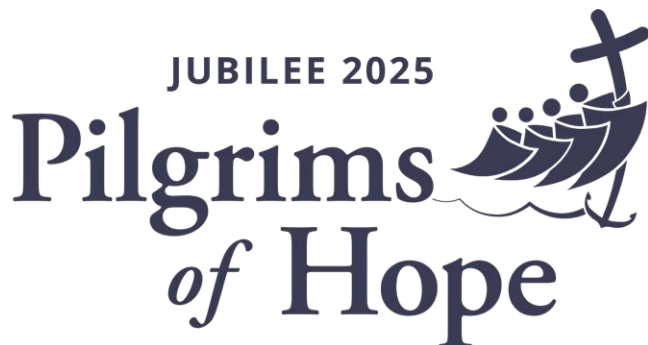
Rocket to the Moon 5k & 1 Mile Walk/Run

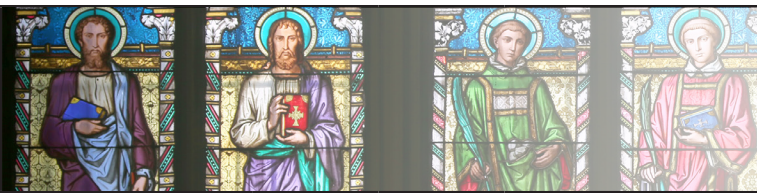

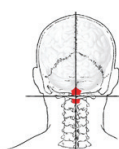
