

# The Saints Are the Masterpiece of God

ast month, Pope Leo canonized two popular saints: St. Pier Giorgio Frassati and St. Carlo Acutis. The jubilee canonizations continue this weekend with a couple more canonizations. I had only heard of one of the new saints, but his story is worth telling. The soon-to-be saint **Bartolo Longo** was born in Italy in 1841 and died in 1926.

Bartolo was baptized Catholic, but fell away from the faith as a young man. Eventually, this led him to occult practices and he became a Satanic priest. However, his life took a turn for the worst. He experienced deep depression and hopelessness. By the grace of God, he renounced his Satanic practices and returned to the Catholic faith. He became devoted to praying the Rosary. He helped fund, raise and build a massive shrine in Pompeii, Italy dedicated to Our Lady of the Holy Rosary. He was a tireless promoter of the Rosary and a dedicated servant of the poor. St. Bartolo Longo, pray for us!

Recently, I updated everyone on some maintenance projects, but I forgot to mention one. As the construction progressed on the Faith Center, the contractors utilized a drone to inspect the building. We asked them to take some pictures of the roof of St. Joseph Church because we have noticed some issues but haven't been able to get a good look at the condition of the roof. The drone pictures confirmed some suspicions, and we are contacting contractors about providing recommendations and

bids on the project. The buildings and grounds committee is reviewing the images to understand the issues.

If you are reading this and haven't had Sunday breakfast yet, there is a pancake breakfast at St. John Hall at 9am on Sunday, October 19. This is part of the 175th anniversary celebrations. As they say, come hungry, leave happy!

Finally, we have another retreat luncheon at the end of the month. These luncheons are geared towards parishioners who are available during the day and uncomfortable with driving to other parish activities after dark. The fall luncheon is Thursday, October 30 and there are more details in the bulletin. We look forward to seeing you there.

#### Scammers

Ignore the message (or report it as a "phishing message") and say a prayer for the scammer.
