Making Assumptions

Today the Church celebrates the Feast of St.
Lawrence, or it normally does. This year's August 10th feast day is superseded by the 19th Sunday in Ordinary Time. When I was in Rome, I was blessed to pray at the tomb of St. Lawrence, who is the patron saint of deacons and comedians. St. Lawrence was a deacon in Rome, assisting Pope Sixtus. During his martyrdom, as he was being grilled alive, St. Lawrence turned to the executioners, saying, "turn me over, I am done on this side."

We are blessed by the service of four deacons in our parish. Two of our deacons are approaching "senior status." The designation "senior status" for deacons in the Archdiocese is given when they reach 75 years of age. They can still do all the typical ministries of deacons, but some of their requirements, like ongoing formation, are lessened. Both Deacon Nick and Deacon Terry will be ministering in reduced ways.

Unfortunately, due to some health issues in the spring, Deacon Nick Jurosic isn't able to see well. He is unable to drive and can't see well enough to read. Sadly, this means that he'll be stepping back from nearly all of his ministry. We have been incredibly blessed by his positive attitude, generous heart, and thoughtful encouragement. Please join me in thanking him for his years of service to Christ and His Church. Feel free to send him a card or stop by and see him during the September 21st coffee and doughnuts at St. John in Fryburg.

Coming up this week is the Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary into heaven. If you remember, we celebrated the Ascension of Jesus on the Sunday

before Pentecost. Interestingly, the liturgical celebration of the Ascension of Jesus is transferred from its traditional Thursday date to Sunday, so that more people can participate.

The understanding of Mary being assumed, body and soul, into heaven flows from the reality that Mary was conceived without sin. Since she had no stain of sin on her soul, she was spared the pain of death and assumed into heaven as the highest honor of our race. August 15 is a Holy Day of Obligation and after the 7:30pm Mass at Immaculate Conception, we'll have our annual Marian Procession through the streets of Botkins. If you haven't ever been, this is a great year to come.

As we gear up for **another year of CCD**, we need more volunteers. Please prayerfully consider taking time to form our young people as disciples in Christ. 


