When I Am Lifted Up

his Monday, August 18th, we'll have a Day of Grace at Immaculate Conception Church in Botkins. Confession and Adoration will be available from 9am to 9pm in the church. This is our Back-to-School special. As you and your families prepare for a new school year, prepare with Jesus Christ Who nourishes you and forgives you.

Last Saturday, we had an appreciation breakfast for all those who participate in Eucharistic Adoration in our two chapels. It was such a blessing to gather these faith-filled parishioners to reflect on the gift of Eucharistic Adoration.

Eucharistic Adoration is basically adoring Jesus Christ, present in the Eucharist. We know that the Eucharist is not a symbol of Jesus' Body and Blood, He is truly present under the appearance of bread and wine. Adoration can happen in two different ways. First, you can always adore the Eucharist in the tabernacle. Whether before or after Mass, or just stopping by for a visit, Jesus is always present in the tabernacle, and you can adore Him there.

The second method of Adoration is called exposition. During exposition, the Body of Christ is placed in a monstrance, to show Jesus to His people. Jesus is lifted up in the monstrance, similar to the way that the Eucharist is lifted up during the Mass. During the Mass, Jesus is lifted up before us and Adoration simply prolongs these moments. Eucharistic Exposition is what happens in our



two adoration chapels. Jesus is lifted up before His adorers.

When Jesus is placed in the monstrance, He is vulnerable. He is able to be stolen, desecrated, and harmed. So someone always needs to be present to Jesus during exposition. One of the things that we discussed during the Adoration breakfast is some instructions that the Vatican gave concerning Perpetual Adoration:

There should always be a sufficient number of people present for Eucharistic Adoration before the Blessed Sacrament exposed (see HCWEMOM. No. 88). Every effort should be made to ensure that there should be at least two people present. There must absolutely never be periods when the Blessed Sacrament is exposed and there is no one present for Adoration.

During many hours in our adoration chapels, there is only one person present. Therefore, we are recruiting more chapel adorers so that there will always be two people present with Our Lord. If you or someone you know is interested in taking a weekly hour in the Adoration chapel in Botkins or Wapakoneta, we are hosting two opportunities to consider the possibility: Saturday, September 27 at 9:30am in the St. Joseph Hall and Monday, September 29 at 6:30pm in the Immaculate Conception basement. If you don't have an adoration hour, please consider coming. Also please pray about bringing someone with you.





Please be aware that scammers have been known to impersonate our priests with a text/email that says something like: "Hi, please return my text when you get it. I have a favor to ask." "Are you available? I have a request for you to manage discreetly." Their text/email will probably even be signed with the name of one of our priests. If you engage with the scammer, they will likely ask for iTunes gift cards. Our priests will never send messages like this. If you're ever questioning a message, please call the parish office before responding. If you've been scammed, ignore the message (or report it as a "phishing message") and say a prayer for the scammer.
