Second Sunday of Lent - March 1st, 2026

The Transfiguration

On the Second Sunday of Lent, our Gospel tells the story of The Transfiguration of Jesus. This year, we read the story from the Gospel according to Matthew (17:1-9). This story is also communicated in Mark (9:2-13) and Luke (9:28-36). In each of the Gospels, The Transfiguration comes shortly after Peter's Confession that Jesus is the Son of God. Shortly after Jesus is identified as the Son of God, He is seen in all His glory. This is important for us to observe. Sometimes, we must acknowledge that God is good, that He is all-loving and all-powerful, before we see it demonstrated.

Jesus takes Peter, James, and John up a high mountain. While they are up on the mountain, Jesus is "transfigured before them; his face shone like the sun and his clothes became white as light." The mountain is regularly a location where people meet God in all His glory. It was on Mount Sinai that Moses beheld the face of God. (Exodus 24) For the three disciples and Moses, they have a profound experience of God.

Peter is so overwhelmed by this experience that he says, "Lord, it is good that we are here. If you wish, I will make three tents here, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah." Peter is so moved by the power of God, he doesn't want the experience to end. Sometimes we have "mountaintop" experiences with God. Maybe at prayer or while on retreat, the glory of the Lord overwhelms us. We can sense His closeness and His love. Hopefully, you've had a moment (or moments) in your life when the Lord has

overwhelmed you with His goodness.

Even though Peter asks if they can stay on the mountain, Jesus says that they must go back down. When they get to the base of the mountain, it is chaos. There is a boy who is possessed by a demon, and the other disciples have tried to perform an exorcism, but were unsuccessful.

When we come off the mountaintop experience with Jesus, there is chaos waiting for us. We don't float on top of the clouds for the rest of our days. This is normal. Our lives are full of day-to-day tasks and frustrating difficulties.

Even though we've left the mountaintop, we don't forget God. St. Peter didn't forget his mountaintop experience. In one of his letters, St. Peter writes, "We had been eyewitnesses of his majesty. For he received honor and glory from God the Father when that unique declaration came to him from the majestic glory, 'This is my Son, my beloved, with whom I am well pleased.' We ourselves heard this voice come from heaven while we were with him on the holy mountain." (2 Peter 1:16-28)

Maybe this week we can gratefully reflect on our mountaintop experiences. The Lord's love can get us through the difficult moments of our life and sustain us in our prayer, fasting, and almsgiving this Lent.

Scammers

Please be aware that scammers have been known to impersonate our priests with a text/email that says something like: "Hi, please return my text when you get it. I have a favor to ask." or "Are you available?" Their text/email will probably even be signed with the name of one of our priests. If you ever question a message, please call the parish office before responding. Ignore the message (or report it as a "phishing message") and say a prayer for the scammer.**
