## The Jubilee Pilgrimage Continues

e are still in the midst of the 2025 Jubilee Year. This is an outpouring of God's love and mercy upon us, His beloved people. Hopefully, you have been able to participate in some events related to the Jubilee Year. In inaugurating the Jubilee Year, Pope Francis stated, "We must fan the flame of hope that has been given us and help everyone to gain new strength and certainty by looking to the future with an open spirit, a trusting heart, and far-sighted vision."

One of the aspects of the Jubilee Year is the pilgrimage. It is incorporated into the theme, "Pilgrims of Hope." There are three officially designated Jubilee pilgrimage locations in our Archdiocese and we have organized pilgrimages to the Shrine of the Holy Relics in Maria Stein and Emmanuel Catholic Church in Dayton. For our pilgrimage to the third pilgrimage location, we are partnering with two other organizations for a trip to Cincinnati.

We are partnering with Journeys Revealed Ministries and Silver Cross Catholic Store for a **Jubilee Year** pilgrimage to the Cathedral Basilica of St. Peter in Chains (the pilgrim site) and Mount St. Mary's Seminary and School of Theology (the bonus visit). The pilgrimage will take place on Monday, November 3, 2025. Interestingly, November 3 is the anniversary of the dedication of the Cathedral Basilica of St. Peter in Chains.

The pilgrimage will leave from Immaculate Conception at 7:30am and return around 8:30pm. Journeys Revealed Ministries is handling the details, so you can register through their website journeysrevealed.com/

pilgrimage. Journeys Revealed Ministries and Silver Cross Catholic Store have organized this pilgrimage in previous years; we are blessed to work with them. It is entitled the "In Persona Christi" Pilgrimage.

Finally, I wanted to give two updates about our parish facilities. As you probably know, we are working on some major capital improvement projects: stained glass windows at St. Lawrence and St. John, the Faith Center at St. Joseph, and a new pipe organ at Immaculate Conception. Those projects are continuing, some nearing completion and others creeping along.

A couple additional projects have arisen over the past year. Immaculate Conception is in need of some tuck-pointing around the northeast entrance. There are some major cracks appearing in the bricks. It doesn't look like we are able to have the masonry work completed before the winter, but it is on the docket.

Also, at St. Lawrence, we are looking at getting new church doors. The current doors are warped, and the locking mechanisms aren't reparable. Also, our various committees are working on adding parking spots and improving safety. If you've been to St. Lawrence, you know that cars travel very fast on Botkins Road. Also, cars are parked in the grass because there are no parking spots available. Unfortunately, the asphalt companies can't get us on their 2025 schedule, so this will likely happen in 2026. This will be an exciting improvement, whenever it occurs.







#### Scammers

Please be aware that scammers have been known to impersonate our priests with a text/email that says something like: "Hi, please return my text when you get it. I have a favor to ask." "Are you available?" Their text/email will probably even be signed with the name of one of our priests. If you engage with the scammer, they will likely ask for iTunes gift cards. Our priests will never send messages like this. If you're ever questioning a message, please call the parish office before responding. Ignore the message (or report it as a "phishing message") and say a prayer for the scammer.


