

All Saints - All Souls - All Glory

n the Church, November starts out with a bang. November 1 is the **Solemnity of All Saints** (All Saints Day). Normally this is a Holy Day of Obligation, but since it falls on a Saturday, it isn't a Holy Day this year. However, many people still like to go to Mass to celebrate All Saints Day. We'll have two Masses, one vigil Mass and one morning Mass for All Saints Day:

- Friday, October 31 at 5:30pm at St. Lawrence Church
- Saturday, November 1 at 8:00am at St. John Church

The Mass at St. Lawrence will involve a little bit more singing than normal; the readings will be chanted.

November 2 is the Commemoration of the Faithful Departed or All Souls' Day. On this day, we remember all the deceased members of the Church, asking God to forgive their sins and lead them to heaven. It is always a powerful day of prayer, intercession, and remembrance. It is a popular day to visit a cemetery to pray for our loved ones.

All Souls' Day trumps the Sunday in Ordinary Time. Instead of celebrating the 31st Sunday in Ordinary Time, we'll be celebrating All Souls' Day; this includes the Saturday vigil Masses. All six regularly scheduled Masses will be for All Souls' Day. There are tons of options for readings. If you'd like to read the ones for our Masses ahead of time, they are listed on the next page.

This year, we'll have our **third annual candlelit** Mass for All Souls' Day. This will occur on Sunday, November 2 at Immaculate Conception at 7pm. This Mass satisfies your Sunday Obligation Mass. We'll be using the same readings for the evening Mass as we utilized for the morning Masses.

Finally, we will have two Family Catechesis nights in the near future. These evenings will take the place of our regularly scheduled CCD nights, and the entire parish is invited to attend. We'll be learning about the saints and the role that they play in our spiritual life. The night for St. Lawrence and Immaculate Conception will be October 29 at 6:45pm at Immaculate Conception Church. The night for St. John and St. Joseph will be November 5 at 6:45pm at St. Joseph Church.


