

## A Time to Celebrate

This weekend, we are celebrating the Feast Day of St. Thérèse of the Child Jesus and the Holy Face (or St. Thérèse of Lisieux). As I mentioned last week, she was named our patron about 17 months ago. If we think about a patron, we get to see a little bit of her role. A "patron of the arts" is someone who is generous to support artistic ventures, sponsoring exhibits, donating to scholarships, etc. A patron of the arts ensures that the arts are promoted and supported.

A parish patron does something similar. They support, encourage, and help a parish to flourish. I believe that St. Thérèse does this for us. Through her intercession and closeness to God the Father, she encourages and supports our parish. She guides us toward the heart of Jesus and encourages all of us to grow in love of God. I hope and pray that you experience the tender mercy of God, through her intercession.

Next week, we'll begin a new initiative in our parish. Maybe it would be better to say an old initiative. You may have heard of the Second Vatican Council which concluded 60 years ago. The council led to numerous changes in the life of the Catholic Church throughout the world. We are still unpacking its vision in teaching. One of the things that the Second Vatican Council taught in its document on the Sacred Liturgy is, "steps should be taken so that the faithful may also be able to say or to sing together in Latin those parts of the Ordinary of the Mass which pertain to them." (paragraph 54)

We often don't think of the Second Vatican Council as encouraging Latin singing, but it does. Further Church documents describe which parts of the Mass the faithful should be able to sing in Latin (and Greek). This may be something new for you (or it may be something that you have forgotten). We are going to take steps over the next few months, so that we can sing the parts of the Mass in Latin (and Greek) that the Church asks us to sing. These will be part of our repertoire.

Next weekend, we'll begin learning the Kyrie, which is the part in Greek. The Kyrie is in the beginning of the Mass during which we acknowledge our sins. "Kyrie Eleison" simply means "Lord, have mercy" and similarly, "Christe Eleison" means "Christ, have mercy." There are very simple chants to accompany this. It should all be relatively easy for us to pick up. In January, we'll begin to learn a couple other parts of the Mass.

Next week, I'm going to visit my family in Georgia. I'll be back Friday afternoon. My niece (8) and nephew (10) have a fall break, and my sister-in-law is a teacher, so she is off as well. Throughout the Universal Church, priests receive 4 weeks of vacation, plus time for a retreat. Sometimes it is difficult to take all the time off, but I know it is important so that I can be the best priest and shepherd possible. Fr. Hoying will be using some of his vacation after I return. Pay attention to the daily Mass calendar in the bulletin because there will be some adjustments.
