What Is in a Name?

oday, we celebrate the Dedication of the Basilica of St. John Lateran. It was dedicated in 324, shortly after Christianity was legalized in the Roman Empire. The official title of the Church is a mouthful, "Major Papal, Patriarchal and Roman Archbasilica, Metropolitan and Primatial Cathedral of the Most Holy Savior and Saints John the Baptist and the Evangelist in Lateran, Mother and Head of All Churches in Rome and in the World." Let's break down this title:

- Major Papal Patriarchal and Roman Archbasilica - There are four major basilicas in Rome. The other three are over the tomb of St. Peter, over the tomb of St. Paul, and dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary. The archbishops of major and historic dioceses throughout the world are given the title "Patriarch." So, there is a "Patriarch of Jerusalem," a "Patriarch of Constantinople," and a "Patriarch of Rome" (i.e., the pope).
- Metropolitan and Primatial Cathedral -Throughout the world, important dioceses are given the title "Archdiocese" and because they are normally located in major metropolitan cities, they are titled "Metropolitan Archdioceses." Primatial refers to the early stages of development. The Primatial Cathedral is the original Cathedral. Believe it or not, St. John Lateran is the Cathedral of the Diocese of Rome
- the Most Holy Savior and Saints John the Baptist and the Evangelist in Lateran - The church is primarily dedicated to Jesus Christ, our Savior. It is dedicated to two different "St. lohns,"

St. John the Baptist and St. John the Evangelist (i.e., Gospel writer and apostle). It is called "in Lateran" because the Lateran Palace was located on this hill, which the Emperor Constantine gave to the Christians. On the land adjoining the palace, the Christians built this church. Thus, the location is known as the "Lateran Hill."

Mother and Head of All Churches in Rome and in the World - Because this is the Cathedral of the Diocese of Rome, it is the head of all churches in Rome. Since Rome is the mother of all dioceses in the world, the Cathedral of Rome is the mother of all churches in the world.

In other news, next Monday, November 17, we'll be beginning a new Hallow Challenge. This one will accompany a giving campaign. Part of our partnership with Hallow includes a giving campaign in which Hallow will match our collections up to \$5,000. We will divide the donations among our four capital improvement projects. Please take advantage of this offer! There are details in the bulletin about how to participate and donate.

Finally, there have been some questions about what will becoming of the current office building at St. Joseph Church when the offices move to the Faith Center (we are looking at a mid-February completion date). At this point, we don't have any firm plans. We are exploring options and if you have thoughts or ideas, please let me know. The building needs some updates, but overall, it is in good shape. I am certain that God has a plan; we are simply taking the necessary steps to discern.
