# Déjà Vu

Last year, I went with my father and Fr. Jarred Kohn to Alaska to hunt the Northern Lights. This past week gave me flashbacks of January in Fairbanks. Hopefully you were able to stay warm. It was déjà vu all over again.

As in years past, we received another generous donation from the **Kleinhenz-Moeller Foundation** to support different ministries in our parish and various capital improvement projects. This foundation has been incredibly generous with our parish over the years and we are incredibly blessed by the millions of dollars that we have received over the last couple decades. Thank you to the trustees for their wise investments and generous distributions.

One of the areas that the Kleinhenz-Moeller Foundation has supported is the young adult ministry. Last week the young adults gathered for a Singo night and they have had a handful of other events. Their kickoff event in the fall was a Trivia night. A handful of parishioners asked if we could have a trivia night for all adults and that is this upcoming weekend. Join us for **Trivia next Saturday, January 31**. There are more details on page 6 of the bulletin.

I know that this was mentioned in previous bulletins and announcements (so you may be getting déjà vu), but this week is both Bill Steinke and Bobbi Donovan's last week at our parish. **We are very grateful for their service to the People of God** for 26 and 6 years, respectively. Also, we are looking to fill their positions as soon as possible. If you know anyone who would be a good fit, please encourage them to apply.

With some personnel changes this coming week, we are going to adjust the office hours. Effective immediately,

**the parish office will open at 9:00am instead of 8:30am** (we will still open at 10:30am on Thursdays). This will give our staff and the volunteers who are helping at the front office an opportunity to attend daily Mass.

We have feast days next week to light up your life. On Monday, February 2, we'll celebrate the **Feast of the Presentation of the Lord (or Candlemas)**. Forty days after Jesus' birth He was presented in the temple and revealed as a "light of revelation," and we traditionally bless candles on this day. If you have candles that you'd like blessed, bring them to Mass with you at Immaculate Conception on Monday. Also Tuesday, February 3rd is the Memorial of St. Blaise. We will have the throat blessing during Mass that day.

Last weekend, we had to move fast on something. For some time, we have known that we needed a new organ at St. John Church. A previous priest told me that the current organ is more suitable for a jazz club than a church. It isn't big enough to support the congregation and doesn't have many features to accompany the congregation. It is also nearing the end of its lifespan. We found a used electric organ in Lima for a great deal. Anthony Moeder investigated it and there were two other people wanting to purchase the organ. We made an offer which was accepted. The organ is in the home of their now-deceased mother, and they don't have urgency in moving the organ. We'll get it moved and add some speakers so that it is more sufficient for the size of St. John Church.

Things sometimes move quickly.


