

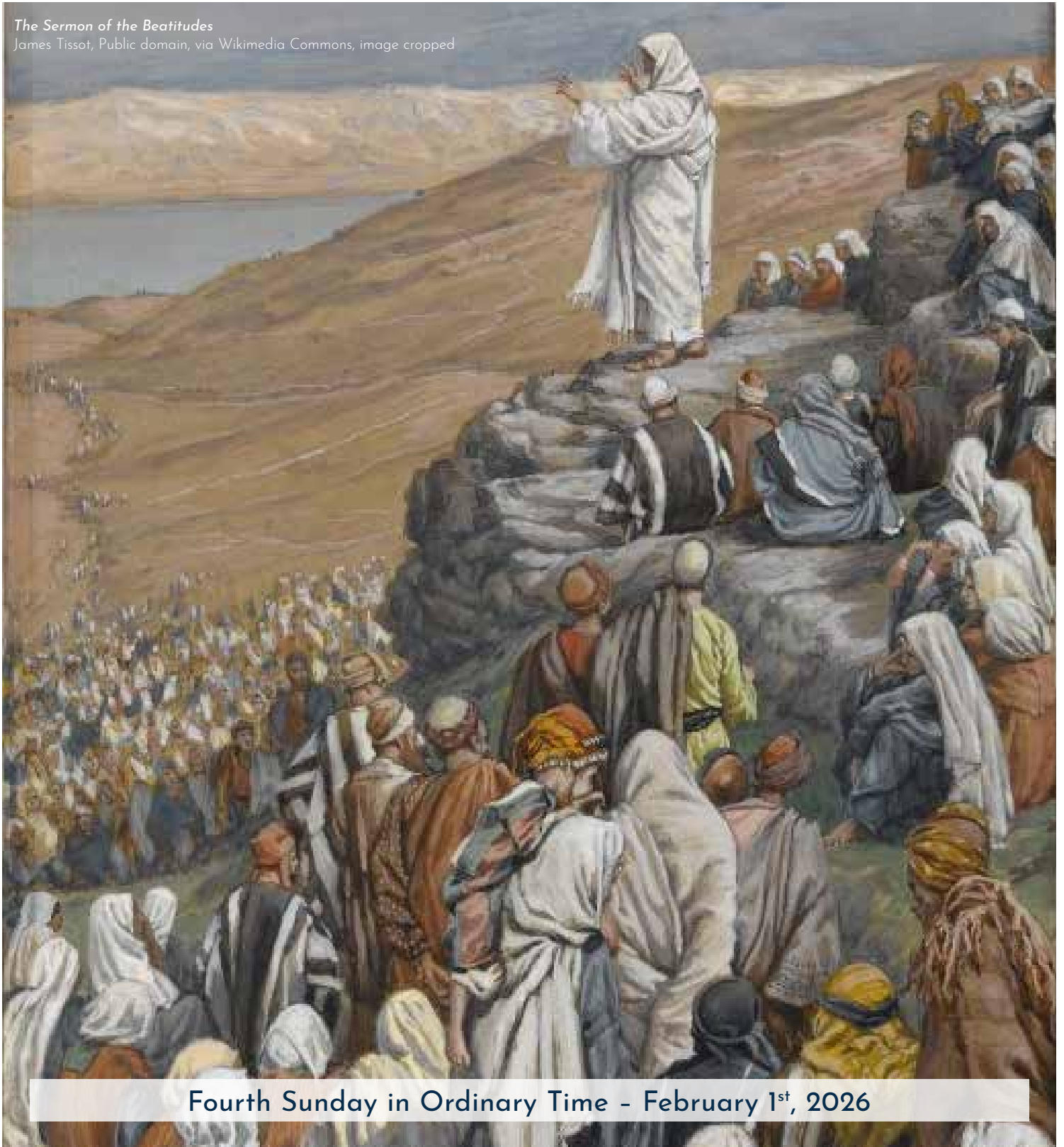

Is Winter Over Yet?

No, winter is not over yet, and who knows if the groundhog will see his shadow on Monday. But there is good news. February is going to be an awesome month to grow in friendship with Jesus Christ.

First, we are celebrating the **Feast of the Presentation of the Lord** on Monday, February 2. Forty Days after Christmas, our Lord was presented in the Temple. Simeon, a random old guy, proclaimed that Jesus is a "light of revelation to the Gentiles." Because Jesus is a light, we bless candles at the Mass. February 2nd is sometimes called "Candlemas." If you have any **holy candles that you would like blessed**, bring them to Mass at 8am at Immaculate Conception. There will be a table in the back for your candles.

Some of the newly blessed candles will be called into service the following day during the Mass for the Feast of St. Blaise. He is famous for curing someone with a throat ailment and so on this day, we bless throats at Mass. If you would like your **throat blessed** come to 8:00am Mass at St. Joseph on Tuesday, February 3rd.

There are three opportunities in the coming weeks to prepare for Lent (Ash Wednesday is February 18). We have two **Family Catechesis nights** on the Wednesdays before Lent: February 4th at Immaculate Conception and February 11th at St. Joseph. We are inviting the CCD students and their families at St. Lawrence to come to IC on 2/4. Similarly, we are inviting the CCD students and their families at

St. John to come to St. Joseph on February 11. All are welcome to these nights, even those without CCD students.

During these two nights, we'll be encouraging everyone to prepare for Lent and be intentional. During this Lent, we want our friendship with Jesus to grow. It takes planning, prayer, discernment, and intentionality to have a fruitful Lent.

Finally, we will be having our parish mission right before Lent. Part of our partnership with Hallow is to host an annual Parish Mission. This is going to be an awesome event to deepen our prayer life and lay the foundation for our life of prayer. Josh Danis, an Ohio native, will be leading the parish mission. He will be inviting us on a great Lenten journey. Sunday, February 15 and Monday, February 16 will be dynamite nights for the mission. **MARK YOUR CALENDARS.**

Part of the Mission will begin with a couple's night on Valentine's Day, February 14th. We'll begin with the 4:30pm Mass at St. Joseph and then head into the St. Joseph Hall for dinner and a talk from Josh Danis, our mission speaker. There are details in the bulletin about tickets for the couple's event.

I pray that you have a very blessed February. Let's not wish this month away. This is another glorious month that the Lord has given for us to grow in friendship with His Son, Jesus Christ.

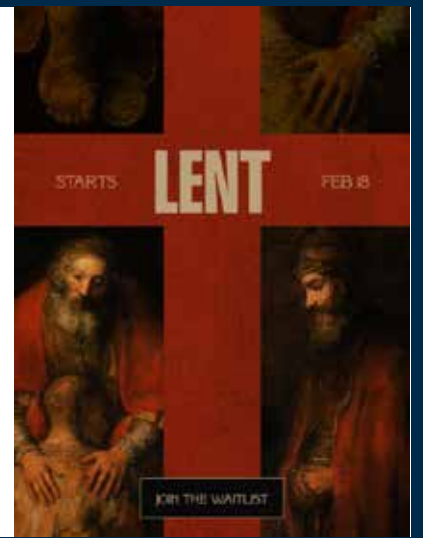

Scammers

Please be aware that scammers have been known to impersonate our priests with a text/email that says something like: "Hi, please return my text when you get it. I have a favor to ask." or "Are you available?" Their text/email will probably even be signed with the name of one of our priests. If you engage with the scammer, they will likely ask for iTunes gift cards. **Our priests will never send messages like this. If you're ever questioning a message, please call the parish office before responding. Ignore the message (or report it as a "phishing message") and say a prayer for the scammer.**
