

- February 22 - we took our candidates and catechumens to Dayton for the Rite of Election
- February 28 - we hosted an engaged couple retreat for seven couples
- March 7 & 8 - we organized two different retreats for our confirmation candidates
- March 14 - we have our First Communion retreat for our second graders
- March 21 - there will be a retreat for our Alpha participants
- March 22 - we'll host our retreat for our candidates and catechumens who will enter the Church
- March 29 is Palm Sunday which begins Holy Week
- April 5 - Easter Sunday
- April 12 - Divine Mercy Service at 3pm
- April 19 - Confirmation Mass in the afternoon
- April 26 - First Communion at Immaculate Conception and St. Lawrence
- May 3 - First Communion at St. John and St. Joseph

On Tuesday, March 17, we'll have a Day of Grace at St. Joseph. Confessions and Adoration will be available from 9am to 9pm.

Thursday, March 19, is the Solemnity of St. Joseph. There will be an evening Mass at St. Joseph Church at 7pm.

On Wednesday of Holy Week (April 1), we'll have a Day of Grace at Immaculate Conception.

Our parish offices will be moving to the newly renovated Faith Center in the middle of April. On Saturday, April 18th we'll be moving boxes from our current office to the Faith Center. If you are available to help, please save-the-date! You can help in the morning, afternoon, or both.

Scammers

Please be aware that scammers have been known to impersonate our priests with a text/email that says something like: "Hi, please return my text when you get it. I have a favor to ask." or "Are you available?" Their text/email will probably even be signed with the name of one of our priests. If you engage with the scammer, they will likely ask for iTunes gift cards. **Our priests will never send messages like this. 
