Happy Easter!

During the Last Supper, Jesus says, "In the world you'll have trouble, but take courage, I have overcome the world." Let these words sink in... Jesus has overcome the world. He has taken upon Himself all the bitterness and pain that exists in humanity and He has risen victorious. In the Resurrection of Jesus from the dead, there is a newfound joy, hope, and peace. May you and your family experience the joy and peace of Jesus' victory.

The joy of Easter doesn't end today. We celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus from the dead all week. At daily Mass, we read the different encounters that Jesus has with His disciples after He rises from the dead. I remember listening to these readings at daily Mass when I was at the University of Dayton. The year that I was at UD, I was discerning the priesthood. The joy and wonder of Jesus' Resurrection led me to follow Him into the priesthood. It was in listening to these Gospels that Jesus called me to follow Him into the seminary and eventually the priesthood.

The weeklong celebration of Easter concludes next Sunday on **Divine Mercy Sunday**. On this Sunday after Easter, Jesus longs to open the floodgates of mercy upon us. Many of us went to Confession during Lent, but I would encourage you to go again soon so that you can receive the graces of Divine Mercy Sunday. Our service will be at 3:00pm on Sunday, April 12th at Immaculate Conception Church in Botkins.

Unfortunately, I won't be present for our Divine Mercy Service. On Saturday, I am flying down to **baptize my newest nephew**. On February 19th, my sister-in-law gave birth to a healthy baby boy, Cameron Sean Wilson. I am

stunned that they gave him my name! What a remarkable honor. It is such a blessing.

After the Baptism on Saturday, April 11th, I get to accompany my father on one of his bucket list items. You may recall that I went with my dad to Alaska fifteen months ago to see the Northern Lights. He gets to check another item off the list. Every year, my dad enters the lottery for tickets to the **Masters Golf Tournament in Augusta, GA** and every year he gets the same response, "You didn't receive tickets. Try again next year." Tickets to the Masters are extremely difficult to obtain, just ask a golfer.

This year, my dad won tickets in the lottery, but not just any tickets. He won two tickets to the final round on Sunday, April 12. He could have won tickets to the practice rounds (Tuesday or Wednesday) or the other days of the tournament (Thursday, Friday, Saturday), but he won final round tickets! I am humbled to get to go with him. My other two brothers couldn't make it to the tournament, but things worked out for me.

You may have noticed that our priest rotation got a little discombobulated this weekend. We decided which priest was going to be at which location based on last year, instead of our normal rotation. Don't worry, we'll get back on our regular rotation shortly. Finally, we are blessed to have Fr. Peter Langenkamp covering Masses this week, so that Fr. Hoying can be off during the week and I can be away next weekend.

- Please remove seasonal decorations at the close of each season (such as Christmas decorations).
- No glass containers are permitted.
- No grave blankets are permitted.
- Flowers left after burial will be removed after 10 days.
- All decorations must be placed on concrete base or monument.

Precepts of the Catholic Church

See Catechism of the Catholic Church, paragraphs 2041-2043

- 1. You shall attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation and rest from servile labor.**
Requires the faithful to participate in the Eucharistic celebration when the Christian community gathers together on the day commemorating the Resurrection of the Lord
- 2. You shall confess your sins at least once a year.**
Ensures preparation for the Eucharist by the reception of the Sacrament of Reconciliation, which continues Baptism's work of conversion and forgiveness
- 3. You shall humbly receive your Creator in Holy Communion at least once a year during the Easter season.**
Guarantees as a minimum the reception of the Lord's Body and Blood in connection with the Paschal feasts, the origin and center of the Christian liturgy
- 4. You shall observe the prescribed days of fasting and abstinence established by the Church.**
Ensures the times of asceticism and penance which prepare us for the liturgical feasts and help us acquire mastery over our instincts and freedom of heart
- 5. You shall provide for the needs of the Church.**
The faithful are obliged to assist with the material needs of the Church, each according to his own ability

Scammers

Please be aware that scammers have been known to impersonate our priests with a text/email that says something like: "Hi, please return my text when you get it. I have a favor to ask." or "Are you available?" Their text/email will probably even be signed with the name of one of our priests. If you engage with the scammer, they will likely ask for iTunes gift cards. **Our priests will never send messages like this.
