Making All Things New

At the end of the Book of Revelation, Jesus tells the people, "Behold, I make all things new." (Rev. 21:5) The Lord continues to refashion us in His Image and Likeness. The grace of the Sacraments also renew us: Baptism renews our souls from the Kingdom of darkness to the Kingdom of Light. This renewal also happens in the Sacrament of Confession.

The Eucharist constantly strengthens us, renewing us week to week with the Bread of Life. Hopefully, you experience renewal each Sunday when you offer prayer and thanksgiving to God and receive His Body and Blood.

Focusing on the Eucharist, on Sunday, June 7, we celebrate Corpus Christi Sunday (Corpus Christi means Body of Christ). On this Sunday, we pay particular attention to the Eucharist and its role in our Catholic life. To prepare ourselves for Corpus Christi Sunday, we are praying a **Eucharistic Novena** on the Hallow App, beginning on May 30. You can join the Eucharistic Novena Challenge on the Church tab of the Hallow App.

In other new items, the **blessing and rededication of the Faith Center** at St. Joseph is next week. We are so blessed to have completed this project. We had some very generous donors and a wonderful committee. It is a blessing to get to repurpose and renovate a 128-year-old building to ensure that parishioners will come to know Jesus Christ here!

The Open House will be from 11am to 1pm on Sunday, May 31. The blessing will take place at 11:30am.

Holiday Closure: The Adoration Chapels are closed for the Memorial Day weekend and will reopen on Tuesday, May 26th at 8am.

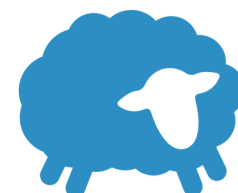
