

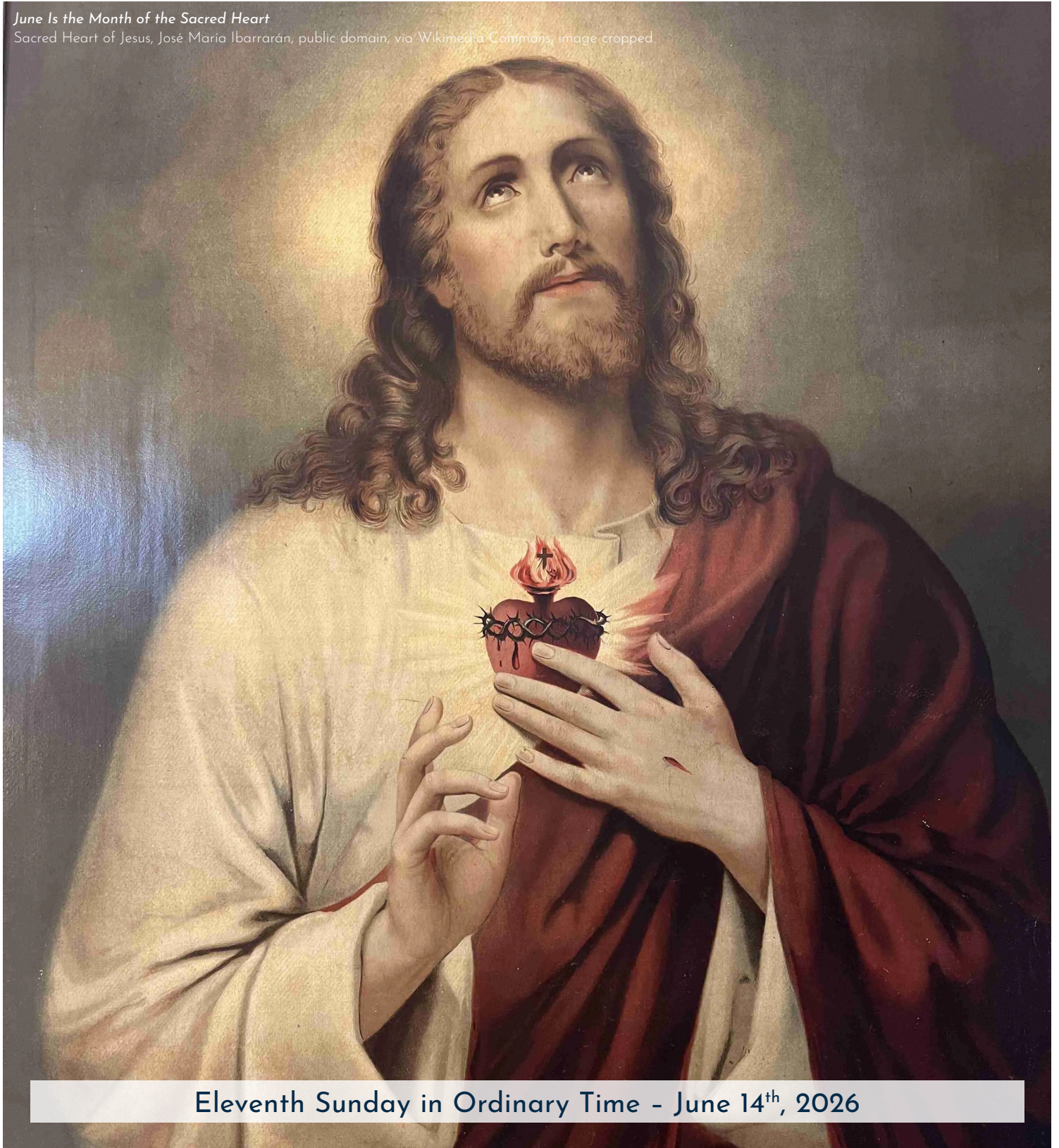

I Get By With a Little Help From My Friends

Priests and Deacons are the most visible people at Mass, which is no surprise. However, it takes a cadre of individuals to beautifully and reverently carry out the Sacred Liturgy. Without the help of many parishioners, our Masses would be much less edifying.

With that in mind, we could use some help in specific areas ASAP. The next liturgical schedule will be released in a week and we'd like to fill out our roster for that schedule. These openings were requested by the leaders of the ministries. If your particular ministry isn't mentioned, I apologize. Let me know at the end of August so that we can recruit more help in September. Here is where we could use some help:

St. Lawrence Sacristans - This is a new ministry for St. Lawrence, so I'd like to have three or four individuals to help get this off the ground. We only need one per Sunday. A sacristan normally sets up for Mass, cleans up afterwards, and does the little things nobody notices (like changes out the candles). It would be great to divide the different Sundays and responsibilities between a small group of people. If you are interested in being a sacristan, contact me (Fr. Immaculate Conception Ushers - Ushers are the fellas that stand at the back of church and look like bouncers. Being an usher isn't rocket science, but it is important. If church is full, ushers help people find seats. They also do the head count at every Mass, take up the collection, and ensure the collection is

properly stored after Mass. We could use about ten or twelve more ushers at Immaculate Conception. If you're interested in being an usher, please call or email the parish office at office@holyfaceparish.org or 419-738-2115.

Immaculate Conception Cantors - This is the only ministry that you need to have some pre-existing skills. The cantor leads and supports the congregation in sung praise of God. If you are interested in being a cantor, reach out to Anthony (anthonym@holyfaceparish.org) to see if it is a good fit for you.

Finally, we are having a **server appreciation night** for our altar servers. Information is on page 6 of the bulletin. We had about twenty young people sign up to be new altar servers and Fr. Hoying gave them top-notch training. Some of the new servers offered to serve at multiple churches in our parish. Therefore, we are going to make a few modifications to our serving practices so that everything is the same throughout the four churches. This will make it easier for servers to go between multiple churches.

Finally, a big thanks to everyone who helps with the Sacred Liturgy at our parish. Oftentimes visitors comment about the beauty, reverence, and participation at Mass. Thank you for making this a reality. May everything we do glorify God!
