American Saints

Around Independence Day we have all probably been reflecting on our country: its values, history, and virtues. Recently, I have also been thinking about its saints. We have numerous incredible American saints. Since there is a little less to write about in bulletin articles during the summer, I thought that I'd write about a different American saint for the next few weeks.

We'll begin with the first American saints, chronologically. The Catholic faith was brought to the United States (and Canada) by a handful of French Jesuit priests. They accompanied French colonists and traders. Eventually they branched out to bring the faith to the Native Americans, largely members of the Huron, Mohawk and Iroquois tribes.

Eight of the missionaries were martyred for the faith, five in current Canadian territory and three in modern-day upstate New York. The three martyred in the United States are St. Rene Goupil, St. Isaac Jogues, and St. Jean de Lalande. They were martyred near Auriesville, NY where the shrine of the North American Martyrs is located.

St. Isaac Jogues was a young Jesuit in France and heard the stories of other missionaries in the New World. Their accounts increased Jogues' desire to "devote himself to labour there for the conversion and welfare of the natives." His first six years were spent learning the customs and languages of the Hurons. He labored for years, traveling from village to village spreading the Gospel. Sometimes there was fruit, oftentimes it was fruitless.

In 1642, he and a few others were traveling through modern day Ontario, when a group of Mohawk raiders kidnapped him. Fr. Jogues underwent various forms of torture including having his fingers gnawed to the bone. He was held in captivity for over a year until the Dutch in New York could arrange his release. In modern-day New York City, he boarded a boat and returned to France where he received permission to celebrate Mass without thumbs.

In 1644, after only a year and a half in France, Jogues returned to North America and by 1646 he was with the Hurons. Quickly a few members of the natives turned against the missionaries, and on October 18, 1646, Fr. Isaac Jogues was tomahawked and thrown into a river.

The early Christian writer Tertullian (155-220AD) wrote that the blood of the martyrs is the seed of the Church. These martyrs gave their lives imitating Jesus Christ, and their offering is the spiritual down payment for our Church in the United States. May their example and intercession continue to fuel us.

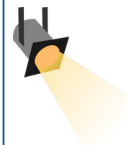

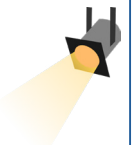

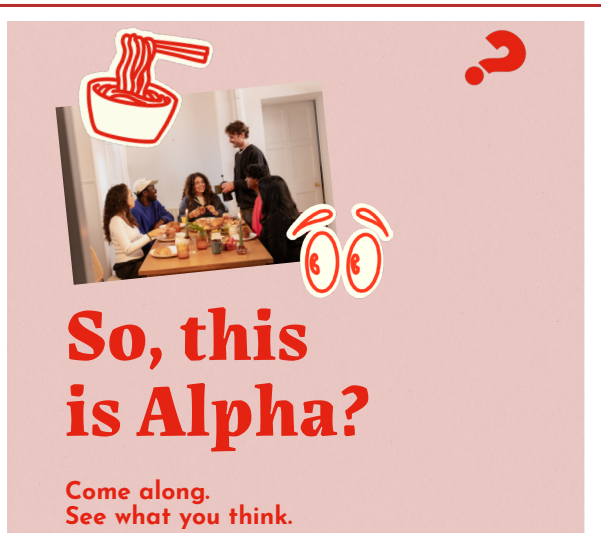
