American Saint Series: St. Kateri Tekakwitha (and more)

In honor of the 250th anniversary of the United States of America, I have decided to write a bulletin series on various American saints. Last week was the first installment about the North American martyrs (specifically St. Isaac Jogues). This week's saint is the fruit of the French Jesuit Missionaries, St. Kateri Tekakwitha (kuh-**teh**-ree teh-kuh-**wi**-thuh).

She was born in upstate New York in 1656 and given the name "Tekakwitha" which means "she who bumps into things," which is a funny name. Tekakwitha was the daughter of a Mohawk chief and an Algonquin woman who was educated and baptized by the missionaries. When she was four, Tekakwitha's parents and only sibling died of smallpox. She also contracted the disease and suffered facial scars and impaired eyesight. After her recovery she lived with her uncle and aunt.

At age 11 she encountered the Jesuit missionaries, and she began to follow the teachings of the Christians, but her uncle was opposed to her conversion. The Jesuits described her as a modest young woman who covered her head due to her scars. Despite this, she was expected to marry but refused, stating, "I can have no spouse but Jesus."

At age 18 she met Fr. Jacques de Lamberville and she began to study the faith under his guidance. In his journal, Fr. de Lamberville stated that she tried to live the Catholic faith in a non-Catholic society which caused some conflicts. At age 19, she was baptized and took the name "Kateri" after St. Catherine of Siena.

After her conversion, she was harassed and opposed by members of her village, accusing her of sorcery. Kateri left home and joined a community of other Native Americans who had become Catholic. She lived there for a few years until her health failed and she died at the age of 24. Those at her bedside noted that her scars disappeared 15 minutes after her death.

About 15 years later (in 1695) the first biography about Kateri was published. Many of her contemporaries considered her a saint noting her charity, purity, and fortitude. She was beatified by Pope St. John Paul II in 1980 and canonized by Pope Benedict XVI in 2012. Her feast day is July 14.

Also, I have the pleasure of informing you that Ernie Steinke is accepting a new role as the Head of Maintenance for the Holy Face of Jesus Parish. A few months ago, Ernie was hired primarily for St. Joseph Church. Now his responsibilities will shift to focus on the entire parish as Domenic Belgiovane is retiring at the end of August. Ernie's primary responsibilities will include maintaining our buildings and grounds (repairs, etc), working with contractors, and setting up facilities for events. We will be hiring a part-time custodian to handle cleaning at St. Joseph.

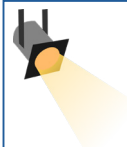

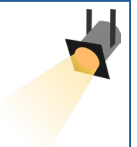

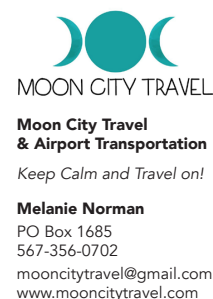
