



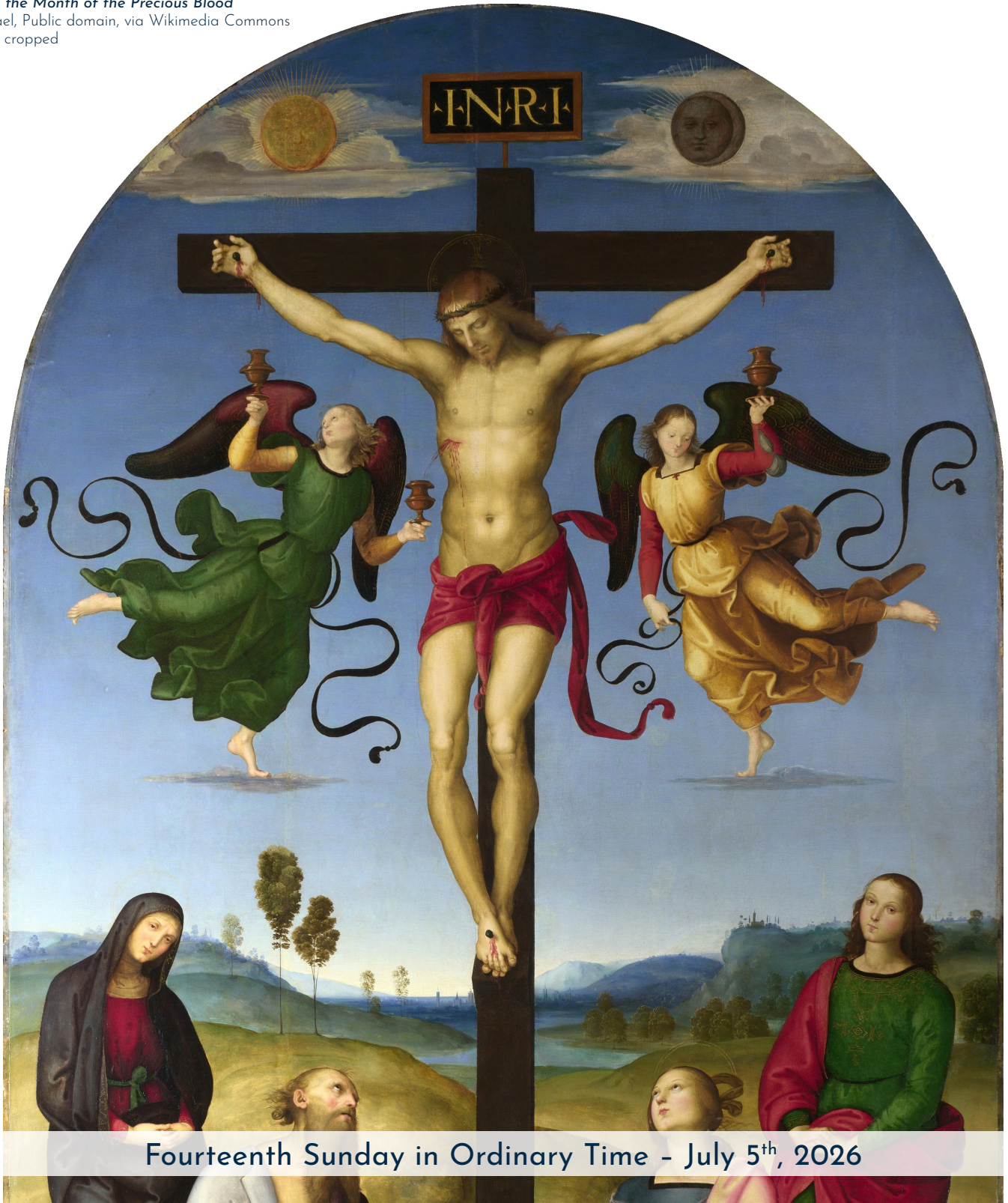

Time Change

This upcoming week, I'll be gone for a couple of days. I'm going with a couple of priests to the Indiana Dunes National Park and I'll be back Thursday evening. You probably won't even notice that I'm away, except that the daily Mass schedule is changed.

As soon as I get back, our high schoolers are going to the Steubenville Conference in Missouri. They'll leave in the middle of the night from Thursday into Friday. The group likes to begin with Mass, so there will be **Mass at Immaculate Conception at 12:15am on Friday, July 10th**. Pray that they have a safe journey and a fruitful experience.

Fr. Hoying will be travelling with them, so there will be a visiting priest next weekend and he'll take a few days of vacation afterwards. Even young whippersnappers need a little bit of time to recover after a trip like that. **Next week (July 13-17), we'll also be on our one Mass schedule.**

I mentioned the other time change in last weekend's bulletin. Beginning on Monday, July 6th, the **parish office will be open Monday-Thursday 9am to 5pm and Friday 9am to noon**. If you are curious about the reasons for the change, please read last week's bulletin.

I don't have anything else exciting to discuss, so I thought I would answer a question that priests often get, **"does this Mass fulfill my Sunday Obligation?"** The answers to what Mass fulfills our Sunday obligation are found in the Code of Canon Law; let's see what it says.

First, the Sunday obligation is found in Canon 1247, "On Sundays and other holy days of obligation, the faithful are obliged to participate in the Mass." This is part of the third commandment to keep holy the Sabbath Day. One of the ways that we keep the day holy is to attend Mass.

The following canon, 1248, continues the discussion of the Sunday obligation, stating, "A person who assists at a Mass celebrated anywhere in a Catholic rite either on the feast day itself or in the evening of the preceding day satisfies the obligation of participating in the Mass."

This naturally raises a question, what does "evening" mean? If you can fulfill the Sunday obligation by attending Mass the evening before the feast, what qualifies as the evening? The short answer: the bishop of the diocese gets to decide. In the Archdiocese of Cincinnati, there has been a decades-long law that any Mass beginning after 2:59pm the day before a holy day fulfills the obligation. In many other dioceses, the rule is an hour later than ours.

This means that any Catholic Mass you attend fulfills this obligation. It doesn't matter which readings are used, if it is a funeral, or if it is in the Byzantine Rite. Any Mass after 2:59pm on the day before or on Sunday (or other Holy Day) fulfills our obligation. If you have any further questions, ask Fr. Hoying. He is much smarter than me.

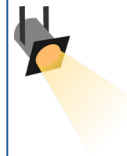

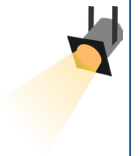
