American Saint Series: St. Theodore Guerin

Born in France in 1798, Anne-Therese Guerin was the third of four children. Unfortunately, her two older brothers didn't live into adulthood, leaving Anne-Therese and a younger sister. Both the girls were educated at home and lived a devout life. They lived the faith as best as possible as France was recovering from the Revolution. Tragedy struck the family again when a group of robbers broke into the house and killed her father. Anne-Therese was only fifteen.

Their mother entered a deep state of depression which forced Anne-Therese to assume the responsibilities of the house. When her younger sister could help more, Anne-Therese got multiple jobs to care for the family. Around the age of twenty, Anne-Therese asked for her mother's blessing to enter a convent, however, motivated by her grief, her mom refused. Five years later, seeing the ardent devotion of her daughter, her mother had a change of heart and allowed Anne-Therese to enter the Sisters of Providence around 1823, taking the name Sister Theodore.

In her early years of religious life, she educated the young and cared for the poor and the sick. At one point, she contracted smallpox which affected her digestive system for the rest of her life. She could only eat bland meals. In 1839, the second bishop of the Diocese of Vincennes, Indiana (now the Archdiocese of Indianapolis) requested French-speaking sisters to aid the young diocese. In 1840, Sister Theodore and five companions traveled to Indiana.

As soon as the sisters arrived, they began establishing schools, first a St. Mary-of-the-Woods College (for women) and then parochial schools. She established Catholic schools throughout the state of Indiana. She also returned to France on fundraising trips to help support the young Church in the United States. They also established orphanages and free pharmacies for the poor. After a life of pouring herself out for the Church in Indiana, Sister Theodore Guerin died in 1856. The Catholic Telegraph in Cincinnati published news of her death, stating:

This woman, distinguished by her eminent virtues, governed the community of which she was the superior from its commencement to the time of her death, a period of nearly sixteen years. Being a perfect religious herself and endowed with mental qualities of a high order, she was peculiarly fitted to fill the duties which Providence assigned her.

Not only her Sisters are bereaved by her death, but all those who knew her excellence and the amount of good she did, join in lamenting that she should have been removed from the sphere of her usefulness. To judge from the celestial expression of her countenance as she lay in death, there is every reason to believe that she has already taken her abode among the Saints in Heaven, enjoying the munificence of God, who rewards His servants "according to their works."

She was canonized by Pope Benedict XVI in 2006 and her feast day is October 3.

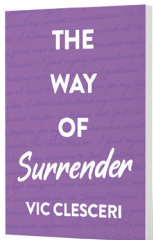

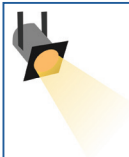
